

Flood of goals from Luton

Brentford 2, Luton 6

Six second-half goals to Luton, four in a 14-minute spell to 18-year-old centre-forward John O'Rourke—an astonishing performance from struggling bottom club Luton, who became the last of the Third Division clubs to get an away win this season.

It was an amazing transformation scene, for Luton had a poor first-half and trailed by a goal scored in the 11th minute by Brentford's Irish international centre-forward Billy McAdams.

The flood of goals to Luton started immediately after the interval through Harry Walden and O'Rourke then Mark Lazarus equalised. Three goals followed from O'Rourke and one from Walden.
