SO, we come to the end of another crowded holiday programme and, with Easter falling early, we have more matches than usual to complete before the end of the season.

The fixture list in April has been crowded by the fact that it was necessary to re-arrange the match with Bristol Rovers for Monday, April 13 and also that the Bedfordshire Professional Cup Final with Bedford Town at Ford End Road, has been fixed for next Monday.

So, in the course of just over three weeks, we have seven matches to fulfil and that is likely to impose a considerable strain on our playing resources. All we can hope is that we will avoid serious injuries and so have the chance of making a bright finish to what has been largely a disappointing season for us.

Today's visitors, Notts County, are old friends and rivals of ours and time was when we were promotion rivals in the Third Division.

Many stern encounters have taken place between the two teams but, possibly, none has been quite so important to either as the one this afternoon.

We both desperately need points to stave off the imminent threat of relegation and the County's need is rather greater

than our own, though goodness knows that we need the points badly enough.

Since he took over as manager, Eddie Lowe, the former Fulham wing half, has not had much luck in his attempts to build a successful side.

At the moment, he is relying largely on local born talent to restore the Meadow Lane fortunes and, like ourselves, the County have been faced with the problem of falling support.

However, in the team is one name which is very well known to us — that of Terry Bly, who led the Norwich forward line in those two hectic Cup semi-finals which we had with the Canaries.

Bly was allowed to move to Peterborough and the County secured him as a replacement for Tony Hateley who they transferred to Aston Villa for a big fee.

Bly is a hard-hitting, dangerous centre forward who will provide another test for our young centre half, Graham Caleb who has settled down so well in League football by putting up a series of successful displays.

With these notes having to be printed before the holiday, it is impossible to dwell on the results to date over the holiday, except to hope that they have been favourable to us and that some of

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

G. H. Smith (goalkeeper). Born Nottingham, and has served the Club since 1953. Very safe and reliable custodian who is acknowledged to be one of the best in the Third Division.

I. K. Hampton (right back). Joined the Club in 1960/61. Played in several positions until settling down as a most promising defender last season. Was formerly with Rotherham United on amateur forms. Born Heanor.

D. Y. Agnew (left back). Joined Notts County during the summer of 1962 from Scunthorpe United. Played in the first four matches last season, but was then a regular reserve. Has also seen service with Leicester City. Born Kilwinning.

R. T. Edwards (right half). Born in Kirkby-in-Ashfield. Came to the Club in Spring 1959 after being rejected by neighbours Nottingham Forest. Signed professional in November of the same year. Has also played at full back.

A. P. S. Gibson (centre half). Born Kinconnell. Joined the Club in April 1959 from Auchinleck Talbot F.C. Very strong tackler, who never admits defeat. Was an ever-present last season, and has tremendous enthusiasm for this game.

H. Loxley (left half). Born Bonsall. Came to Notts County in Spring 1952. League debut 1954/55, and has been a

regular first team player since. Our longest serving player.

K. F. Fry (outside right). Born Cardiff, and a former Welsh Schoolboy International. Joined the Club from Newport County in February 1962. Very clever ball player with strong shot.

J. Sheridan (inside right). Joined the Club from Linby Colliery in 1955. A strong tackler who uses the ball extremely well. Has also played at half back. Born Ramsgate.

T. Bly (centre forward). Signed from Coventry City recently. Previous clubs were Peterborough United and Norwich City. While at Norwich was in the team which had such a good F.A. Cup run in Season 1958/59 and played in the two semi-final games against Luton Town.

R. J. Tait (inside left). Born Edinburgh. Joined the Club in the summer of 1962 after previous service with Aberdeen and Elgin City. Originally an outside left, but towards the end of last season proved his worth as an inside forward and netted at frequent intervals.

A. J. Flower (outside left). Born Carlton and joined the Club straight from school in February 1960. Signed professional in February 1962 after a spell on the ground staff. Last season he played at outside left chiefly but can also operate at inside forward.
