Club Notes

A NEW season is always a notable event and we welcome supporters tonight in the hope that we shall be able to go one better than we did on Saturday when the team made an encouraging start by taking a point from Brentford.

This was especially cheering because it was virtually a 10 men performance since, after only a quarter of an hour, John O'Rourke badly damaged an ankle.

Earlier, he had underlined his powers of opportunism by scoring in the first minute and the players themselves felt that they would have had a good chance of repeating their win of last season on this ground had they remained at full strength.

Unfortunately, O'Rourke's injury made him a doubtful starter for tonight's match in which we welcome Colchester United, and we were already carrying the burden of having another forward, Billy Hails, on the injured list.

Every club has to expect and budget for, mishaps of this sort, but we had hoped that if they had to come, they would not affect the atack, cover for which was weakened before the season began by the fact that Ray Smith for whom we paid Northampton a sizeable fee less than 12 months ago, has failed to report back for training.

Cover for the attack is something the manager has had under review, but he was hopeful of seeing what various young members of his staff and those who are having trial periods can do, before having recourse to the transfer market.

However, in view of the situation that has developed, Mr. Harvey was negotiating for a top-class player whom he hoped to have in his line-up tonight.

Throughout the summer, he has purposely avoided spending the limited money that is available in order to see exactly what is needed and he came to the conclusion on Monday that this was the time to make a decisive move.

Of necessity, these notes had to be written before the outcome of the deal was known or before the result of a fitness test on O'Rourke, but those who have been critical of the comparative lack of activity in the transfer market during the close season, can be assured that everything possible will be done to increase the cover for those positions which need it.

Colchester, who are now managed by Neil Franklin, famous ex-Stoke City and England centre half, who took over when Benny Fenton moved on to Leyton Orient, are a useful combination who, however, did not emerge as one of the top flight teams last season, and it will be a disappointment if we do not collect full points this evening.

If that is accomplished successfully, then we shall hope for a considerably bigger than average crowd for the next home match which will be against Bristol Rovers on Saturday.

Supporters are asked to note that there is a new licensed bar under the Grand Stand which will be open at all matches this season.

It has proved successful during the summer when we have run a series of wrestling tournaments and the local magistrates have now given us permission to open two more licensed bars, one behind each goal, and structural alterations are now taking place so that they can be opened as soon as possible.
