IN two games, Luton have netted nine goals and had seven scored against them, a fact which makes for exciting football for the fans—but also a deal of worry about Luton's defence.

Against Barnsley, the Hatters were coasting home with a four-goal lead in 19 minutes

Billy Stark gave them the tonic of a goal in two minutes when he headed in a corner from Billy Harber, and goals by Ray Whittaker, Tony Read and John O'Rourke followed in quick succession.

But Barnsley fought back and scored through John Bettany and Martin Ferguson before half-time.

In the 73rd minute Luton inside-right Tony Read scored with a long shot over the goal-keepers' head.

Three minutes later Kerr got Barnsley's third goal and with only seconds left Ferguson scored their fourth.
