Certainly, we will not forget in a hurry the two hard battles we had with Romford in the F.A. Cup and they have given us fair warning that the meeting with Corby on the Northampton club's ground in the next round will certainly be no sinecure.

Obviously, this is not going to be adequate and the only way in which we can approach the problem is on the basis of first come, first served.

Season ticket holders are asked to apply immediately, enclosing their second round slip, remittance and stamped, addressed envelope and the first 150 will be supplied strictly on the basis of one ticket per person.

Admission to the remaining parts of the ground will be by payment at the

turnstiles and even though the holding capacity of the ground is limited to 12,000 there should be room for everyone who wants to see this match.

Before this comes around, there are three vital League matches to be faced in the course of eight days with the first today against Notts County, old friends and rivals of ours from Second and Third Division days.

Like us, the County are making an urgent bid to regain some lost status and we expect a hard battle for the points but, naturally, we are hoping for a continuance of our bright form at home with two more points.

Then, on Tuesday, comes another trip into Yorkshire to meet Doncaster Rovers, one of the stronger teams in the Fourth Division. For us, the Belle Vue ground has happy memories because it was here
