Substitute Tony Read was sent off in the forty-second minute . Jardine following him to the dressing rooms five minutes later.

Provoked

Left half John Moore and inside right Tom Mc-Kechnie were booked and goalkeeper Colin Tinsley and centre half Matt Woods cautioned.

Jardine told me: "In eight years as a professional I've never been booked before—let alone sent off. Hartlepools weren't interested in letting us play

football."
Read said: "The referee

sent me off for butting. But we were provoked throughout the game."
