

# A DAY OF DISASTER FOR LUTON

**F**ULL back Freddie Jardine yesterday described Luton's 2-0 crash at Hartlepool as "the dirtiest game I have ever played in."

Jardine was one of two players sent off on a day of disaster for the Fourth Division club.

Inside forward Bruce Rioch was carried off with a leg injury after thirty-two minutes.

Substitute Tony Read was sent off in the forty-second minute . . . Jardine following him to the dressing rooms five minutes later.

## Provoked

Left half John Moore and inside right Tom McKechie were booked and goalkeeper Colin Tinsley and centre half Matt Woods cautioned.

Jardine told me: "In eight years as a professional I've never been booked before—let alone sent off. Hartlepool weren't interested in letting us play football."

Read said: "The referee sent me off for butting. But we were provoked throughout the game."
