

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Peter Wakeham (Goalkeeper). Transferred to Lincoln City from Charlton on 7th May, 1965, a regular first team player with Charlton. Born in Kingsbridge one of his previous Clubs was Sunderland.

Alf Jones (full back). Born in Liverpool previously with Leeds United, was transferred to Lincoln City in July, 1961. Made 41 first team appearances last season.

Jeff Smith (full back). Born Warren (Sheffield). First signed for Sheffield United in 1954 and was with the United for five seasons. Transferred to Lincoln City in February, 1958, and has developed at Sincil Bank into a sound defender. Made 33 league appearances last season.

John Milner (wing half). Born Huddersfield, with this club for four seasons, transferred from Huddersfield to Lincoln on 30th October, 1963. Made 28 first team appearances last season.
