With his ability to appear in so many different positions, Gibson is the type we could not afford to lose it is only hoped that his recovery will be speedy.

Unfortunately, it was impossible to play the match at Newport last Monday because of the badly waterlogged condition of the pitch. So, the match was put off for the second time, without us, on this occasion, having to make a wasted journey.

Just when it will be fitted in, is not settled yet, but it seems that the last week of the season, ending May 28th, is the only convenient time for us. Meanwhile, we have arranged to visit Halifax on Monday, May 16th, kick-off 7.30 p.m.

Nor were our Reserves any luckier in their attempt to play off their match at Aldershot on Wednesday. Again, the heavy rain won the day and the decision for postponement was made in time to prevent the team beginning their journey.

The Reserves, by the way, completed their home programme by winning against Watford last Saturday and, after today's game at Colchester have just two away matches outstanding.
