TONY READ (Goal)—born at Haydock; his first club was Sheffield Wednesday, and in 1964 he left them to go to Peterborough, for whom he also played at centre-forward; he was transferred to Luton in March, 1965.

BOBBY THOMSON (RB) — born at Menstrie in Scotland; he first came into prominence with Partick Thistle, and was later transferred to Liverpool for a big fee; Luton secured his services from the latter club on 2nd Aug. 1965.

ALAN SLOUGH (LB)—another Luton boy who has graduated from the ranks of Schoolboy, Amateur and Apprentice Professional; he gave very good displays last season; can also play with distinction at wing-half and inside-forward.

GORDON RIDDICK (RH)—turned professional in April, 1961, following a short period of apprenticeship; tall, with good ball control and a very good shot, much is expected of this lad as he gains more experience.

**JOHN REID (IR)**—previously played for Bradford and Northampton, to whom Luton paid a substantial transfer fee in November, 1963; he has settled down well at Luton, and is a tireless and energetic worker.

**JOHN O'ROURKE (CF)**—was previously with the Arsenal and Chelsea, from whom Luton signed him on a free transfer in December, 1965; last season he was dogged by injuries.

**BRUCE RIOCH (IL)** — although born at Aldershot he was brought up in Luton, and first attracted the attention of this club when playing for Luton Schoolboys; he also had trials for the England Schoolboys' team; signed professional in September, 1964.

**RAY WHITTAKER (OL)**—a Londoner from Bow, his only other club being the Arsenal; joined Luton in March, 1964; he went straight into the First Team and held his place for the remainder of the season.

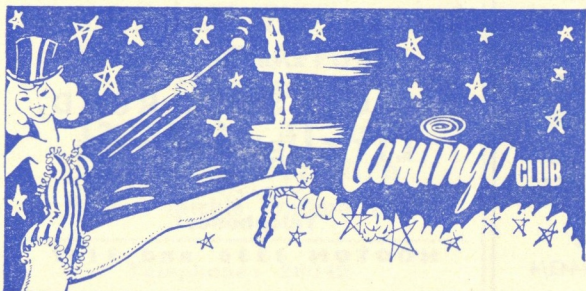

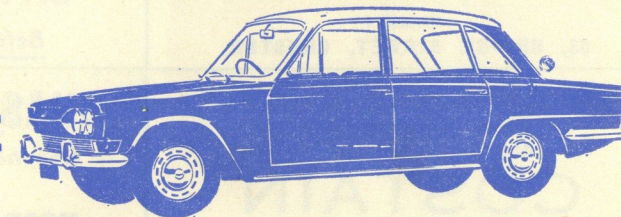

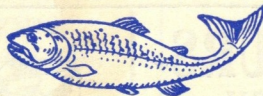
