Club Notes

AS a result of making a draw at Aldershot on Wednesday last we find ourselves engaged in the Replay of the First Round Tie of the Football League Cup tonight, on this August Bank Holday Monday. Our boys put up a very creditable show at Aldershot after suffering a first minute shock when the home team took the lead through centre forward Rafferty. This was no doubt a fillip to Manager David Smith's boys whom we welcome here tonight and their supporters called on them to keep it up. However it was Luton who fought back strongly and by half time had got on to level terms when Rav Whittaker scored direct from a free-kick. This surprised the Aldershot defence who seemed to expect him to float the ball over to the far post, for they all stood still whilst the ball went in to the other end of the goal. The second half was keenly fought and Luton took the lead through Freddie Jardine Again it started from a free kick near the centre line taken by Alan Slough, who lofted the ball goalwards. This was headed on by Gordon Riddick to Freddie who had made his way up the left wing and he drove the ball hard into the goal. Following this Aldershot came back strongly and it took some brilliant saves from Tony Read to keep them at bay, before he was again beaten by Ron Raffertey Even in the last minute the Town might have won this game, for Tony Thear. who was making his debut for Luton, broke through the middle and crashed in a tremendous shot which smacked the cross-bar hard then bounced over. Full marks to both teams for the way they played the match and we look forward to another interesting and exciting game. On Saturday, 20th August last, at

half-time during our match against Halifax, we held the draw for a Vauxhall Viva car, supplied by Messrs, Shaw & Kilburn of Dunstable Road, Luton, and given away free by our Pools Club. The winning ticket was for Week 1 and numbered 00940. The lucky holder was Mr E Rollings of 6, Downs Road, Dunstable who was presented with the car on Friday last, so we trust that he has had a happy motoring week-end. 
