These notes had to be written before last Friday's game at York and so we do not know whether that match brought an improvement and signs of the players regaining their touch.

It was interesting to note that after the Barrow game almost every individual spoken to seemed to offer a different reason for the defeat, and a different remedy. Everyone, however, was disappointed, and there were a number threatening to stay away from Spotland until results prove that things have changed.

We can only hope that there will not be too many of these, and that they will quickly have good reason to end their boycott. The opening home game attracted a crowd of only 2,700. It should be clear that the club cannot be run with any success on that kind of support, and there will be even less chance of success if support falls below that low figure.

Whilst the team which met Barrow lost through their own efforts it cannot be overlooked that we have been terribly unlucky with injuries to experienced key men.

Perhaps one or two of the absentees will be fit to come into the team for to-night's game against Luton Town, one of the Fourth Division clubs to miss promotion by a narrow margin last season.

In that campaign Luton were able to win all four points from their two meetings with Rochdale. We recall that their victory at Luton was decided by an injury to Bob Stephenson which came at a time when Rochdale were well on top.

- TONY READ**—Goal Keeper. Born at Haydock, his first Club was Sheffield Wednesday, and in 1964 he left them to go to Peterborough. Was then transferred from there to Luton in March 1965 to show his versatility, he last season made 35 appearances in the forward line scoring 12 goals besides six appearances in goal.
- ALAN SLOUGH**—Full Back. Another Luton boy who has graduated through the ranks of Schoolboy, Amateur and Apprentice Professional, being offered Full Terms in May, 1965. He is another boy on whom the Club will pin its faith for the future. Can also play with distinction at Wing Half and Inside Forward, in fact he gained County Representative honours as an Amateur in the latter position.
- FREDDIE JARDINE**—Full Back. Although born in Edinburgh, he played for two seasons for Dundee before coming South to Luton in 1961. Was signed as an Outside Left but has since made the Left Back position his own.
- BOBBY THOMSON**—Full Back. Born at Montrie in Scotland. He first came into prominence with Partick Thistle and was later transferred to Liverpool for a big fee. Luton secured his services from the latter Club on the 2nd August, 1965.
- ALAN RIVERS**—Half Back. Born at Portsmouth he signed Professional forms for this Club in January 1964, after playing three years for us as an Amateur. He is a very well built lad who can also play with success at Centre Forward.
- JOHN MOORE**—Wing Half. In his second season for Luton. Previously played for Motherwell. Made 43 League appearances and scored five goals last season which can be said to be a satisfactory baptism into English football.
- DAVID PLEAT**—Winger. Born at Nottingham. He played for England Youth Team and also Nottingham Forest, from whom we secured his transfer in August, 1964. Was a regular member of our First Team until he had the great misfortune to break a leg. Now recovered he is determined to make his presence felt once more.
- GERALD KING**—Winger. A Welshman by birth, he played for his country both as a Schoolboy and at Youth International level. Has played for Cardiff and Torquay, from whom he was transferred in June, 1966.
- GORDON RIDDICK**—Inside Forward. Turned Professional in April 1961 following a short period of Apprenticeship. He has been with this Club since this date making many first team appearances equally well at Full Back, Half Back and as a Forward. He was Born at Langlebury.

He signed Apprentice Professional in August, 1963 and full Professional in September 1964. Made 21 League appearances last season.
- RAY WHITTAKER**—Outside Left. A Londoner from Bow, his only other Club being the Arsenal. He gained England Youth International Caps in 1962 and 1963 and when we were in need of a left wing he was persuaded to join us in March, 1964. He went straight into the First Team and held his place ever since.

**THE FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION**

The Association shall be entitled to publish in the public press, or in any other manner it shall think fit reports of its proceedings, acts and resolutions whether the same shall or shall not reflect on the character or conduct of any Club, Official, Player, or Spectator, and every such Club, Official, Player, or Spectator shall be deemed to have assented to such publication.

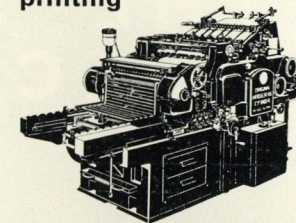
