If things had gone well, two experienced players would have been available to reinforce the first team pool, but although Manager George Martin spent much time in trying to organise the deals, he had to admit failure.

In one case, he was decidedly unlucky because there is no doubt that he would have secured the player he wanted from a First Division club had they not been so beset by injuries.

Of these, we are having our share. unfortunately, and were having to face up to the fact that it was unlikely that Ray Whittaker would be in today's lineup because of the knce injury he received at Barnsley last Saturday.

Then, we hoped to open our away account, but had to yield by 2-1 in a gaine that never reached the heights.

With two strong leads having disapneared almost overnight, the manager new has to start his search for reinforcements afresh, because it has now become obvious, with injuries occurring nearly every week, that there has to be some extension of the experienced material available.

While the team has not made a great start, purely because of the inability so far to collect away points, the feeling is that not much needs doing in order for the team to repeat its success of last season.

Had this week's transfer activity proved to be successful, then we might well have found ourselves at that happy stage

Meanwhile, there can be no underestimating the difficulty of the task that awaits the team this afternoon. In their bid to secure promotion, Stockport have gone for experienced players in a very big way and their team is dotted liberally with players who have made their names in a higher grade of football.

So far, the policy is paying off handsomely because they are unbeaten and come here this afternoon as League leaders with nine points out of a possible 10.

Not that they will find that record easy to maintain today, because there has not been much wrong with our team's home form in League games and the players are keenly aware of the importance of winning this one, which is the first of three home matches in succession

Next Saturday, Aldershot will be here and, on the following Thursday, will come the return with Rochdale. In the meantime, the Reserves also have a home match, against Southend United, next Thursday (kick-off 7.30) and the hope is that the young team will show that they have benefited by the experience of the two previous matches.
