Next opponents for tonight's winners will be Bristol Rovers at Eastville, a ground on which a succession of Luton teams has had a great deal of experience and let it be said, mixed fortunes, too.

One handicap under which the team has been labouring recently is the continued absence through illness of Graham French. Not only is he not available tonight, but it seems unlikely that he will be in the team for the vital match at Lincoln on Saturday.

Fortunately, it looked, when these notes were written, that our casualties of last Saturday, Bobby Thomson and Bruce Rioch would have made a full recovery and that was certainly a relief in the circumstances.

Assuming that there is a definite result tonight, the Bedfordshire Professional Cup Semi-final with Dunstable Town will be staged on this ground on Monday, kick-off 7.30 p.m.

Winners will meet the holders, Bedford Town, in the final, probably at the end of the season, and there should be quite a welcome for our former players in the Dunstable ranks, Seamus Dunne, Terry Kelly, Alan Clarke, Ken Hawkes, Colin Bishop, Jackie Walker and Mick Forsyth.

On Saturday, the ground has been loaned to the Bedfordshire F.A. for their F.A. County Youth Cup-tie with Essex (3 p.m.) and a most entertaining match is expected.

After not having had a home League match for a month, the team resumes in front of their own supporters on Saturday week when Chesterfield are the visitors.

- T. Smout (Goalkeeper). A Welsh boy who had made his mark with Crystal Palace, joined Exeter during this close season.
- C. Smythe (full back). Came from Distillery. Born Belfast, signed August 1962, made 43 League appearances last season.
- G. Ley (full back). Born Exminster, previous clubs Arsenal and Hitchin Tsigned September 1963, a winger successfully converted to full back.
- E. Wilkinson (wing half), Born Chesterfield signed this close season from Arsenal whom he joined from leaving school, during his period at Highbury he established a reputation as a hard working defender
- K. Harvey (centre half). Born Crediton, signed August 1952, made 40 League appearances last season. Made Trainer August 1966.

Jimmy Blain (wing half). Signed from Carlisle early 1966. Born Liverpool, can play on the wing or inside forward.

- P. Godfrey (outside right), Hard working winger signed during close season from Chesterfield, previously with Gillingham where he made over 100 Football League appearances. Is also a hairdresser by profession.
- R. Keeley (inside forward). Another young signing from the London club. Born Wandsworth. A very promising forward, made his debut in Second Division against Derby County after progressing through the junior teams. Joined Exeter in March last season.

- G. McLean (centre forward). Previous club Grimsby. Born Paisley. Signed 1965. Formerly with Glasgow Rangers. Top scorer with Grimsby, Exeter's most expensive signing last summer.


