Kenlilworth Road by 2-0 after a 1-1 draw at St James's Park.

Three weeks ago, in Devon, we were beaten 2-1 which was almost a ludicrous result on the run of the play, especially that in the first half when the team played really well.

It was in this match that Bruce Rioch received the injury which has been aggravated since and led to him, at the beginning of the week to be ordered a rest for a fortnight.

At the moment, injuries are posing something of a problem and it is unfortunate for player and club that the promising Brian Johnson should be out of action at this juncture.

Although the Reserves went down 4-0 to O.P.R. at Loftus Road on Wednesday. they were firmly in the game for an hour and are hoping for a better result when they receive Colchester United next Wednesday, kick-off 7.30 p.m.

During last season and this, several local firms and also individual wellwishers, have been kind enough to give us match balls which is something we appreciate very much.

Now, we find that the supply for the remainder of the season is in danger of running out and offers would be more than welcome.

- T. Smout. A Welsh boy who made his mark with Crystal Palace, joined Exeter during this close season.
- B. Emburry. Joined the Club from Tottenham Hotspur where he was a highly rated member of the young reserves XI, which were so successful in the London Combination. Joined Tottenham on leaving school, and has developed into a cool defensive player.
- G. Ley. Born Exminster, previous clubs Arsenal and Hitchin Town signed September 1963, a winger successfully converted to full back.
- E. Wilkinson. Born Chesterfield, signed this close season from Arsenal who he joined from leaving school, during his period at Highbury he established a reputation as a hard working defender.
- R. Harford. Born Halifax, commenced his professional career with Charlton, came up from the Colts, utility defender. Played wing half when signed early in 1966, moved to centre half, established himself in this position. Made 16 League appearances last season. Attracted many clubs interest during the final games of last season.


