After the match on United's ground, came our first ever visit to York City on Saturday and the hope is that, not only has our stock of points been increased, but that no further injuries have been collected to complicate the task of team selection for today.

Fortunately, last week saw some easing of the position, with Bruce Rioch, who had been out of action for over a month, following a bad kick on the leg, being passed as fit for the start of the holiday period.

Another who looked like being available, if needed, was young Brian Johnson who resumed full training at the start of last week on his recovery from kneeligament trouble.

Unhappily, the story so far as Alan Slough is concerned is less fortunate because he broke down again in training which ruled him out for this week-end, and we now await news of the exact extent of the damage and what steps will have to be taken to remedy it.

The picture has been brighter so far as recent results are concerned because, before Friday's game at Hartlepools, the team had gone four matches without defeat, collected seven points in the process, and that was their best run of the season.

Those points have served to ease anxiety about the re-election situation and, naturally, we are hoping that as the result of the holiday matches, the fear has been swept away completely.

On the other hand, we were only too well aware that Hartlepools, managed by the former England, Sunderland and Middlesbrough centre forward, Brian Clough, would be tough opposition, especially as they were in with a chance of promotion.

There is another home match on Saturday when Port Vale, of whom Sir Stanley Matthews is in charge, will be here and this could be another vital encounter.

Today, the Directors have as their guest, Mr. Parry, of 132, Cutenhoe Road, Luton, who will be 74 years of age tomorrow.

Mr. Parry saw his first Luton Town match in 1905 and has been a regular supporter at both League and Reserves' matches ever since, and the Board felt that they should reward his great loyalty by having him as a special guest.

Born at Atherstone and was transferred to the club in November 1965 from Burton Albion, Made 19 First Team appearances in season 1965/66.


