LEAST said, soonest mended, about our Easter programme which proved to be such a major disappointment in that it yielded us not a single point

Yet, it cannot be dismissed completely because it leaves us still involved in the re-election issue and, from the look of things before today's match, the team must average a point from the nine remaining games, to be safe,

Last weekend opened promising enough with the team within inches of gaining a point at Hartlepools, which was regarded as the hardest task of the three. and increased confidence in our ability to gain some reward from York the following day.

Alas, it proved to be misplaced because after holding the City and being right in the game for two-thirds of it, things went badly wrong and the defeat was unexpectedly severe.

On the basis of what happened at Hartlepools, hopes were high that there would be another victory to record in the return on Monday, but the biggest crowd we have had since January 14 were vastly disappointed

Maybe, there would have been a different story had Manager Allan Brown had his full strength from which to choose for these vital matches and, in view of the limited resources at his disposal, it was a big handicap to have to go through this period without established first team players like Bruce Rioch and Alan Slough.

Then, on Monday, the position was aggravated by the fact that Bobby Thomson had to stand down. This was an occasion on which the team so badly

wanted to do well but, having missed their chances in the opening stages, they allowed Hartlepools to take a grip and there could be no complaint about the result.

Now, we look for two points today from Port Vale, who did us a good turn over the holiday by completing the double over Rochdale and gave themselves a very welcome lift in the table.

With the legendary Sir Stanley Matthews in charge, assisted by ex-Scottish International, Jackie Mudie, they are particularly welcome, especially as both were Blackpool team-mates of Allan Brown.

This is a match which we must win and the hope earlier in the week was that the injury position would allow the team to be nearer to full strength.

Extra attraction today is the presence of some of C'esar's Maidens, from C'esar's night spot, and they will hand the match ball to the referee, make the Pools Club's draw at half-time and, it is hoped, be introduced to Sir Stanley on the pitch.


