#### **OUR VISITORS**

The Luton Town Club was formed just over 80 years ago by a fusion of two

local clubs, The Wanderers and The Excelsion.

Luton claim to be the oldest professional club in the South of England. In 1890, an offer of 5/- per week was made to three of their players and for the following season, all their first team players were paid, the agreed amount being 2/6 per week, with an extra 6d. for away games, with allowance for work lost on Saturday morning when that applied.

Luton had three seasons in the Football League Second Division from 1897/8 to 1899/1900, but then reverted to the Southern League and remained therein until

that League became, in the main, the Third Division (South) in 1920.

They were Champions of that Division in 1936/7. In 1954/5, "The Hatters" won promotion to the First Division. Birmingham, Luton Town and Rotherham United all finished with 54 points, and Rotherham were the unlucky ones to miss promotion on goal average.

Luton remained in the premier grade until 1959/60 when they were relegated

to Division Two along with Leeds United.

In 1962/63 they finished in the relegation position of the Second Division and fell into Division Three, and then at the end of 1964/5 they fell into the Fourth Division.

Last season, they had 56 points to finish sixth, nine points and five places higher than us. Luton beat us 3-1 in each game in 1965/6.

This season we are fellow-strugglers in the re-election zone.

FRENCH, Graham (winger). Born at Wolverhampton. Come into prominence when playing for Shrewsbury. Later he played for Swindon and Watford before joining Luton in October, 1965.

JARDINE, Freddie (full-back). Although born in Edinburgh, he played for two seasons for Dundee before coming south to Luton in 1961.

KING, Gerald (winger). A Welshman by birth, he has played for Cardiff and Torquay, from whom he was transferred in June, 1966.

MOORE, John (wing-half). In his second season for Luton. Previously played for Motherwell.

PLEAT, David (winger). Born at Nottingham. Played for Nottingham Forest, from whom his transfer was secured in August, 1964.

**READ, Tony** (goalkeeper). Born at Haydock. His first club was Sheffield Wednesday, and in 1964 he went to Peterborough. Was transferred from there to Luton in March, 1965.

RIOCH, Bruce (inside-forward). Although born at Aldershot, he was brought up in Luton. He signed apprentice professional in August, 1963, and full professional in September, 1964.

**THOMSON, Bobby** (full-back). Born at Menstrie in Scotland. First came into prominence with Partick Thistle, and was later transferred to Liverpool. Luton secured his services from the latter club in August, 1965.

WHITTAKER, Ray (outside-left). A Londoner from Bow, his only other club being Arsenal. Joined Luton in March, 1964.
