Club Notes

UPPERMOST in the minds of most of our players this afternoon will be the memory of that disastrous December day when they crashed by 8-1 to Lincoln City at Sincil Bank, the worst debacle suffered by the club in years.

There was some excuse for it because several members of the team had not recovered by any means from the grueling Cup tie replay with Exeter City two days before and it was this fact that caused a change of mind about the day for mid-week matches.

Almost immediately afterwards, it was decided that Wednesday should be the day and not Thursday, as had been the case for some time.

Bottom of the League, Lincoln seem doomed to have to apply for re-election to the Fourth Division for the fourth time. That does not mean that they will not be fighting to improve their record this afternoon and the fact that they secured a point here, which we could not afford to lose, almost 12 months ago, is something that we have not forgotten.

More than that, results in mid-week have combined so that it is vitally necessary that we should make no mistake about acquiring two points today, and on the form of the last two home matches, there should be no doubt about that.

There was a mixed bag for the team last weekend which began promising with a hard won point from Bradford after a disappointing game in which Luton were the more constructive team,

but failed to find the necessary thrust in front of goal which could have brought the second away victory of the season.

A good first half display at Southend on Monday, raised hopes that yet another point could be acquired against a team that was desperate for success to keep alive their promotion hopes.

As the game went into its last half an hour with still no goal scored, prospects of a draw seemed promising, especially as the defence was throwing back the Southend raids with some authority.

However, the first goal made a great deal of difference to Southend who grew in confidence after that, so that at the end, we had no real quarrel with the 2-0 defeat, although Southend officials were full of praise for the resistance put up by our weakened team.

Absent for the first time this season, because of an ankle injury, was Freddie Jardine, and the captaincy was taken over by Max Dougan. In Freddie's place at left back was young Terry Adamson, who did not do at all badly, but Jardine was expected to be back in the line-up today.

This has been a busy week for the club with the Reserves having had two fixtures to fulfil, as a result of which, our resources have been stretched to the full, and there have been further chances for local amateurs, including a couple of members of our youth team.

The crowded programme for the Reserves continues next week, with visits to Leyton Orient and Colchester on Monday and Wednesday respectively.

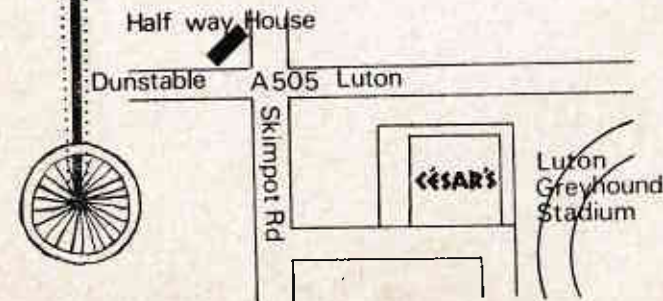
