Club Notes

BUT for abnormally wet weather at that time and the fact that our playing pitch is unable to absorb the water as it did, this afternoon's match with York City would have been played on Saturday January 28th, the date of the third round of the F.A. Cup.

Object of trying to bring forward the game was to give more time to repair the ravages of the pitch on which major drainage is necessary and will be begun immediately.

Unfortunately, on the previous occasion we were unable to prevent York from completing their journey, as they were travelling by train and they arrived at Luton station before they knew that the referee had considered conditions impossible.

However, it was one of those occasions when we were powerless to save them unnecessary travel.

Like us, York, whose first visit to this ground this is, have been in the wrong half of the table for most of the season and have been more deeply embroiled in the re-election issue than have we ourselves.

Although the draw at Chesterfield last Saturday, did much to alleviate anxiety, it may well be that we need a point from this match to be absolutely certain.

On the other hand, York's slim chance of avoiding the last four, rested on Rochdale being beaten last night, winning here today, and Notts County being beaten in both their remaining matches, which seems a somewhat impracticable proposition.

Whereas before Easter, York seemed doomed, they have made a remarkable

improvement since, including a 5-1 victory on Easter Saturday over our team who will be looking for revenge today.

Unfortunately, we shall be without Ray Whittaker who is in the middle of a 14 days period of suspension after having been sent off the field at Crewe.

He also missed the Professional Cup match at Bedford, as did two other regular members of the forward line, Graham French and Keith Allen.

Upshot was a 3-1 defeat in the match with Bedford which has always seemed to pose problems for successive Luton teams.

So we come to the end of a season which has been something of a disappointment after our narrow failure to win promotion 12 months ago.

However, Manager Allan Brown has a very clear idea of his needs for next season and already has enquiries in hand for players for the positions he feels most need strengthening.

We thank the loyal supporters and all the many other people who do numerous tasks for us for their continuing and constant support and hope that their rank's will be considerably bigger when the new season begins.

Harry Fallon (goalkeeper). Signed from St. Johnstone in September, 1965. Fearless 'keeper who made 32 appearances last season. Scottish Junior International.

Gerry Baker (full back). In his third season with the City. Formerly with Nottingham Forest. Appeared in the League side 44 times last season. A versatile player who has also appeared at centre forward and centre half.

Ken Turner (full back). An experienced defender who joined the club during the close season from Shrewsbury Town. Formerly with Huddersfield Town, where he under-studied Ray Wilson.

Trevor Wolstenholme (wing half). Former Birmingham City wing half, signed during the close season from Torquay United.

Barry Jackson (centre half). Seasoned pivot. Local born player who has rendered yeoman service to the City Club. A wholehearted player in his tenth season with the Club for whom he has been regular first choice. Made 45 League appearances last season.

Phil Burrows (wing half). Signed during the close season from Manchester City. A promising wing half from whom big things are expected.

Rowland Horrey (winger). Close season signing from Blackburn Rovers. Young North East born player who interested City before moving to Blackburn. Should add strength and purpose to the forward line. Can occupy either wing position.

John Goodchild (inside forward). Signed in the close season from Brighton and Hove Albion, where he was a regular First Team player for 5 seasons. Started his career with Sunderland.

Dennis Walker (inside forward). Starting his third season with City whom he joined from Manchester United. A stylish ball playing inside forward. Appeared in the League side 41 times last season.

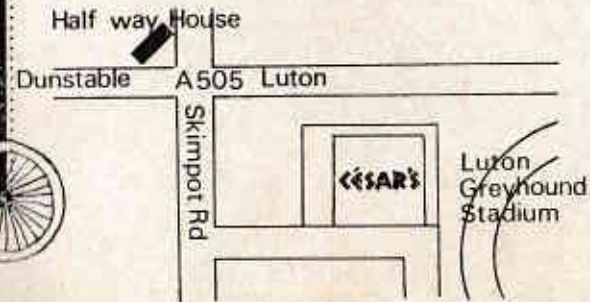
