

RIOCH HEADER PUTS LUTON THROUGH IN EXTRA TIME

Charlton Athletic ... 1 Luton Town 2

(After extra time)

TWO goals from Bruce Rioch won Luton a tie at Leeds in the League Cup second round after extra time in last night's replay at The Valley. The vital goal came in the 17th minute of extra time when Rioch nodded in a long cross from Whit-

taker. Charlton had opened well against the Fourth Division side, taking the lead only 55 seconds with a three-yard header by Tees.

The game soon deteriorated, but Luton equalised after 36 minutes when Rioch followed up to score at the second attempt.

The referee, Roger Kirkpatrick (Leicester) stunned the crowd, 50 seconds after half-time by sprinting

off the field. He threatened to abandon the game if a spectator behind the Luton goal continued to blow a whistle.

After Peacock had substituted for Keirs, who went off with concussion, the match went into extra time. In the dying seconds Read, the Luton goalkeeper, pushed an effort from Tees against a post from where the ball went for a corner.
