

I realise that after last week's game against Aldershot, things look a little more severe than they really are. Last Saurday's game was such that, although I felt basically we were the better team, the luck was with Aldershot; we should have gone in at half-time three goals up. However, they had the luck and hit a "purple patch" in which two goals were scored from fantastic angles-and, of course, one felt that then the luck was against us. I am extremely hopeful that we can recoup the two points, lost last week, to-day.

Our playing staff is still under strength with the players who are still not yet match-fit, and the three players who have been placed on the Open-to-Transfer List -Ryden, Reeves and Singleton. I feel that our immediate need must be a strong defender and a goalscoring insideforward.

I am sure that you are all aware that our Chairman, Mr. Rowlands, will be entering hospital to-morrow for an operation, and we all sincerely wish him a speedy and complete recovery, and we hope that he is soon with us again.

TONY READ (Goal)-born at Haydock, his first club was Sheffield Wednesday; later moved to Peterborough, from whom Luton secured him in March, 1965; is equally well at home in the centre-forward position.

BILLY McDERMENT (RB)-born at Paisley: was transferred from Leicester City in July, 1967; has a reputation of being a rugged type of player.

FREDDIE JARDINE (LB)-another Scot. from Edinburgh; played for Dundee before coming South to Luton in 1961; although originally an outside-left, he has now settled into the left-back position.

MAX DOUGAN (RH)-cost Luton a sizeable transfer fee in December, 1966; his two previous clubs were Queen's Park (Scotland) and Leicester City; gained five Amateur International Caps whilst with the former.

TERRY BRANSTON (CH)-signed in June from Northampton Town, for whom he played regularly, and has appeared in all four divisions of the Football League; was born at Rugby.

JOHN MOORE (LH)-in his third season at Luton, being a regular member of the 1st Team; previously played for Motherwell; was born at Hart Hill (Scotland).



GRAHAM FRENCH (OR)-born at Wolverhampton; has previously played for Shrewsbury, Swindon, Watford and Wellington, before joining Luton in October, 1965; has several Youth International Caps for England.

IAN BUXTON (IR)-transferred from Derby County on 27th Sept., 1967, for a five-figure fee; made regular appearances for Derby 1st Team and scored a number of goals for them; was bought as a replacement for Rodney Green, who had to go into hospital for a cartilage operation

KEITH ALLEN (CF)-joined Luton from Stockport, in exchange for Derek Kevan, in March, 1967; quickly became a favourite; previously played for Grimsby and Portsmouth; a native of the Isle of Wight.

BRUCE RIOCH (IL)-born at Aldershot; lived in Luton most of his life; first signed for Luton as an apprentice in 1963, taking the full-time ticket in September, 1964, and is a regular member of the 1st Team.

RAY WHITTAKER (OL)—a Londoner, from Bow, he played for the Arsenal, with whom he gained England Youth International Caps before joining Luton in March, 1964; has been a regular member of the 1st Team ever since.


