

# LUTON SHAKEN BY REVIVAL

**Luton 5, Doncaster 3**

This game provides a lesson for Luton, though they evaded the full consequences—the danger of taking for granted an apparently impregnable position.

Four goals up in 18 minutes through Buxton (2), Slough and Allen, they reached half-time 5-1 ahead, Rioch having scored the fifth after Watson replied for Doncaster.

The biggest crowd of the season—13,925—was agog for more goals, and there was talk of a double-figure score, but although they still had more of the play Luton became over-elaborate.

## RANKS CLOSED

### Ambitious attacks

Doncaster had a chance to close ranks, which they did to some effect. They began to attack ambitiously and shook Luton with two goals in four minutes by Warboys and Kelly near the end.

That gave the score-line an erroneous look, because confident Luton were always in command. But those two goals exposed the lack of quick covering.
