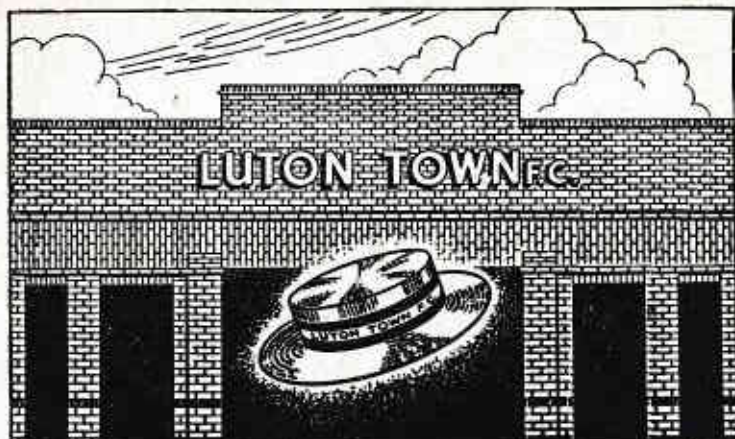

Club Notes

NOT for many years has confidence in our camp been so high as it stands at the moment. Three consecutive victories, two of them away, have rounded off a splendid start to the season, and the 5-0 victory at Exeter was our most decisive on an opponent's ground for a very long time.

As a result, we are very comfortably placed among the leaders and are completely confident that this is our season for promotion.

Indeed, victory against Doncaster tonight and Darlington, who are the visitors here on Saturday, could well put us at the top of the division by the weekend.

There is an extra spur to overcome Doncaster in that they are only one of two Fourth Division teams, the other being Southend United, who have managed to lower our colours in 13 matches this season. They have a vastly experienced team who are bound to put up a hard fight, but our form at home should ensure two more points.

This game marks the home League debut of John Ryan, who used to partner Allan Brown on the wing for Wigan Athletic and if he repeats his success at Exeter, where he made the first three goals, then he will soon become a firm favourite with the crowd.

The support we are receiving at the moment is most encouraging and provides yet another reason why we are so anxious to make the first step back to the club's former glory.

Hopes are for another five figures crowd on Saturday when, Darlington who, like Doncaster, were relegated last season, will be the visitors.

In view of the recent happenings at Millwall, it becomes all the more essential that our younger supporters should not encroach on the playing area at any time.

Not that we are suggesting, for a minute, that they are likely to cause any trouble but if they remain on the terraces, and we mean to take every precaution that they do so, then even the slightest doubt will not arise.

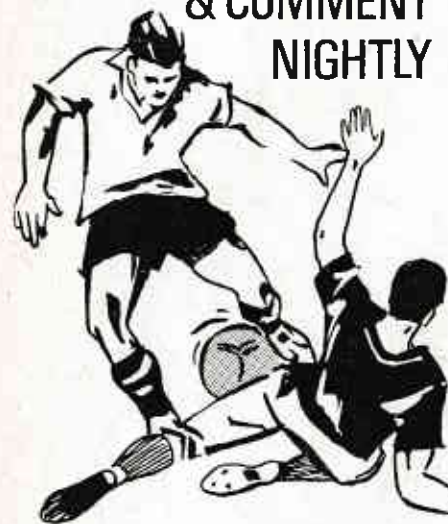
