Before that, there is a most important fixture to fulfil next Saturday when Bradford City, one of the more prominent, front runners in the promotion race, will be our hosts at Valley Parade Because of the clash with the Bradford Northern - Australian tourists match under Rugby League rules, the City wanted to switch to an evening kick-off

To this we would not agree because we felt that the true soccer follower would prefer to see our villal match, and the inconvenience of starting the return journey at a late hour for both the Luton fans and the team, was also taken into account.

Next Tuesday will see the start of the installation of individual, tip-up seats in the gand. First priority will be given to Blocks A. B. C and D. which are occupied by season ticket holders, but it is expected that the whole work will be completed well before Christmas.




