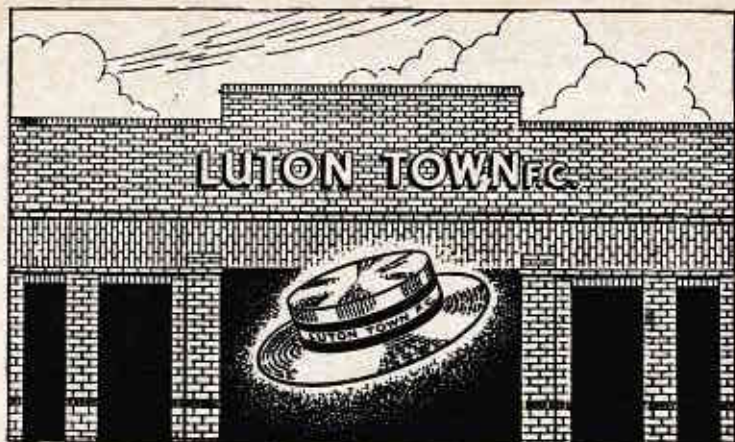

It is a tribute to the managerial ability of Allan Brown that he has brought about this transformation in just 12 months and it is no wonder that everyone connected with the club and the vast majority of the supporters are already looking forward to Third Division football next season.

With success on the field is combined the return of prosperity in the shape of support through the turnstiles and we feel that, in most home games this season the team have given the fans full value for money.

We hope this support will continue, and even increase, especially as there are some attractive, possibly vital matches looming up next month when Darlington, Wrexham and Barnsley can all be expected to provide strong opposition.

Before that, there is a most important fixture to fulfil next Saturday when Bradford City, one of the more prominent, front runners in the promotion race, will be our hosts at Valley Parade. Because of the clash with the Bradford Northern—Australian tourists match under Rugby League rules, the City wanted to switch to an evening kick-off.

To this we would not agree because we felt that the true soccer follower would prefer to see our vital match, and the inconvenience of starting the return

journey at a late hour for both the Luton fans and the team, was also taken into account.

Next Tuesday will see the start of the installation of individual, tip-up seats in the stand. First priority will be given to Blocks A, B, C and D, which are occupied by season ticket holders, but it is expected that the whole work will be completed well before Christmas.

Season ticket holders are reminded that they have only until today week to make application for seats for our Cup-Tie at Oxford. Only a few are left, at 6/- and 5/-, but there are still plenty of standing tickets at 4/-.

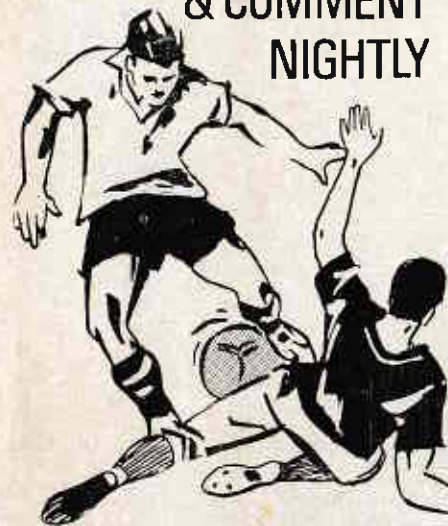
