A fortnight today, Lincoln City are the visitors and will be followed two days later by Darlington whose previous visit here was washed out by a deluge after play had been in progress only seven minutes.

Before those two engagements, we have a couple of tough away fixtures to fulfil, with a visit to Griffin Park, Brenttford, n'exit Saturday, followed by one to Aldershot on the following Wednesday for a game that was postponed because the pitch was waterlogged on November 4th

For both these fixtures, we can reasonably expect to take a big following and, certainly, the one to Brentford will be increased materially should we gain the hoped for good result against Rochidale today.

Earlier in the season, we forced a 2-2 draw alt Spotland and the fervent hope is that the team will bring to an end the recent run of three consecutive draws with a convincing first win of 1968

Goals have not been coming so frequently of late as we would like but.

doubtless, the preponderance of away games has been partly responsible for this and, in addition, there is the fact of injuries, at times, to key forwards which have not been helpful.

Even though, the form of the team in recent weeks, it is a fact that the results of the last two matches on opponents' grounds which brought a point from each, were saitisfactory and it now remains for the team to resume its consistently winning form at home.

A fortnight today, an added attraction here will be a display by Police Dogs, including obedience tests, which will precede the start of Crime Detection Week in the town which the local police force aim to make a memorable event.


