Club Notes

Without doubt, last week was the most triumphant of the season because the team, despite being badly handicapped by injuries, secured two away victories in four days to take an even firmer grip on the Division IV leadership and to increase, materially, the hope that we shall be champions of the Fourth Division.

At Aldershot, there was a following of encouraging size to see the team give a workmanlike display that gained them a well-earned victory.

Again, the professionalism and responsibility of the side was emphasised at Darlington on Saturday when Manager Allan Brown decided on a 4-3-3 system which has been used little this season, but which was forced upon him by the acute shortage of wingers.

Again, the plan paid off and, here it is pertinent to pay tribute to the way in which the replacements for the injured players took their chances.

Today, we are expecting a big attendance for the return meeting with Aldershot which, in terms of distance in the Fourth Division, is almost a local derby. Despite their recent lapses, there is no doubt that the Hampshire side will come here determined to wipe out the memory of their defeat on their own ground and we do not expect other than a hard fought game.

Next Saturday, we face our longest journey of the season, to Cumberland, to meet Workington whom we have visited only once before, when defeat by the only goal was our portion.

Meanwhile, on this ground, there will be a full ration of football next Saturday, with the Youth team meeting Orient in a South East Counties League match in

the morning (11 a.m.) and the County Senior Cup Final between Vauxhall Motors and Leighton Town taking place in the afternoon (3 o'clock).

On Thursday, kick-off 7.15 p.m. Luton Boys meet Leicester Boys here, for the Seaward Trophy.

We have received several complaints about the bad language that is being used by a section of the crowd behind the Oak Road goal and would ask those responsible to remember that people come here to enjoy themselves and not to have their afternoon ruined by an irresponsible few.

Tony Godfrey (goalkeeper). Played 166 League and Cup games in eight years with Southampton before joining Aldershot in December 1965. Tony did not miss a First Team game last season.

Len Walker (centre half). Born Ferryhill, Co. Durham. Was with Spennymoor United before joining Newcastle United. Signed for Aldershot in July 1963. Len did not miss a First Team game last season.

Malcolm Dawes (half back). Is a product of North East football. Born at Trimdon Grange, Co. Durham. Was signed from Horden in August 1965.

Peter Madden (centre half). Signed during the close season from Bradford Park Avenue, for whom he played one year. Previously with Rotherham United for eleven years. Peter has had a lot of Football League experience. Born Bradford.

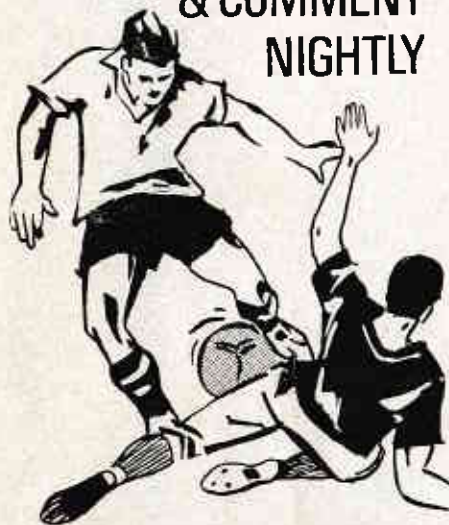
