OBVIOUSLY, these notes had to be written before the result of yesterday's home match with Notts County was known and it can only be hoped that the team got off to the holiday period on the right foot.

Certainly, we are hoping that this week end will finally bring the fulfilment of our hopes for promotion which looked reasonably certain after last week's victory at Workington which was the 14th match in which the team had avoided defeat.

To press home our bid for the championship, a convincing victory is needed today over Chester, who have the advantage of not having had a match yesterday. Instead, they are playing their home game with Bradford City on Tuesday.

This is an important weekend for the Cheshire team who have had such a disappointing season that they are in real danger of having to apply for re-election though they have been showing some improvement in recent weeks.

For us, there is the chance of yet another double because it was at Sealand Road, Chester, way back in October, that we secured our first away win of the season by 3-1. Since then, there have been six others to record, and the completion of four doubles.

On Monday, we are due at Nottingham for the return with the County and those who intend to travel should note that the kick-off has been timed for 7.30 p.m.

Despite the appeal to a section of the crowd at the Oak Road end to moderate their language, we have had further

complaints that abusive language is still being used.

We appeal again to the irresponsible few and warn that, if this continues, we shall be forced to take sterner measures.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Dennis Reeves. Dennis won his place in the First Team through the junior teams. Signed professional forms in September 1963. Born Lochmaben, Scotland.

Tommy Singleton. Born Blackpool. Tommy was signed from Peterborough United in the close season of 1965/66 for a small fee. Although originally bought as a full back he plays equally well at centre half.

Peter Hauser. Born Kimberley, South Africa, Peter joined Chester in August 1963 from Cheltenham, as Player-Manager. He was previously with Blackpool, for whom he played inside forward or wing half.

John Butler. John was born in Birmingham, joined Chester from Notts County in June 1962. He has given Chester excellent service at both full back and centre half, only missed one game season 1965/66.

Micky Metcalf. Born Liverpool, he joined Chester from Wrexham in December 1963. Mick was an ever present last season.

Hugh Ryden. A Scot. born Renton. Hughie was transferred from Stockport in June 1964, has been a regular First Team player since joining the Club, and possesses a strong shot in either foot.

Les Jones. Born Wrexham. Signed from Tranmere Rovers in April 1965, was previously with Bolton Wanderers. Les was Chester's top goalscorer last season.

Elfed Morris. Born Colwyn Bay, North Wales. Is now in his fifth season with Club. Signed from Wrexham F.C.

Eddie Loyden. Born Liverpool. Eddie joined the Blackpool's ground staff on leaving school, he then signed for Carlisle before he joined Chester in the close season of 1966/67.

Terry Carling. Born Otley, in Yorkshire. Terry was discovered in minor soccer by Leeds United, who signed him in 1957. Transferred to Lincoln City in 1962, and to Walsall in 1965—for whom he was ever present 1965/66. Signed for Chester on December 10th 1966.

Mike Sutton. Born Norwich, for whom he played on leaving school. Signed during this close season. Made 60 First Team appearances for Norwich.

Ian Moir. Born Aberdeen, Scotland. Ian made the trip across the border to Manchester United, for whom he was on the ground staff for several seasons. Joined Blackpool in February 1966, and was a regular First Team player. Signed for Chester in May 1967.

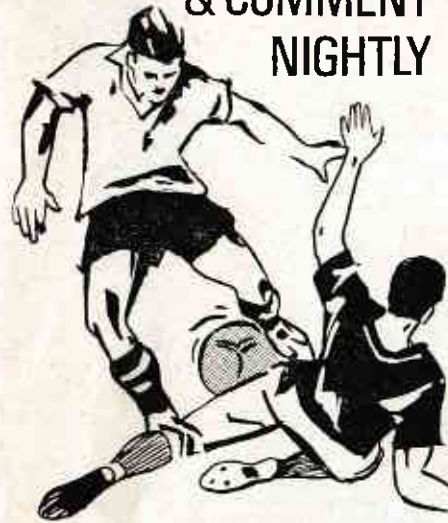

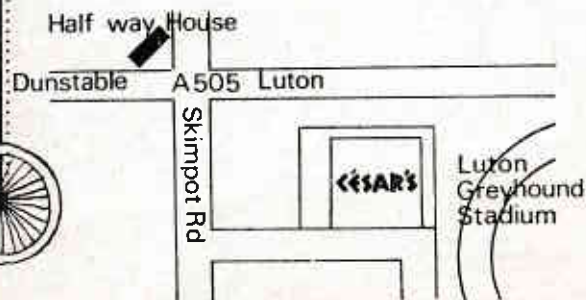
