This is an important weekend for the Cheshire team who have had such a disappointing season that they are in real danger of having to apply for re-election though they have been showing some improvement in recent weeks.



John Butler. John was born in Birmingham, joined Chester from Norts County in June 1962. He has given Chester excellent service at both full back and centre half, only missed one game season 1965/66.

Micky Metcalf. Born Liverpool, he joined Chester from Wrexham in December 1963. Mick was an ever present last sca's'on.

Hugh Ryden. A Scot. born Renton. Hughie was transferred from Stockport in June 1964, has been a regular First Team player since joining the Club, and possesses a strong shot in either foot.

Les Jones, Born Wrexham. Signed from Tranmere Rovers in April 1965, was previously with Bolton Wanderers. Les was Chester's top goalscorer last season,




