Target now, for Allan Brown is to set up a new points for the Fourth Division which looks a feasible proposition because three points from the three remaining matches will accomplish this.

Next Saturday, we go to Crewe and our season ends the following week with the visit of Brentford, which will be another big occasion because this will mark the presentation by the League of the Division IV trophy.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Jack Marsh (goalkeeper). Was signed as a full time professional in June 1966 at the age of 18. A native of Leeds, he joined City from a Leeds Junior side.

Alec Smith (full back). Was born at Thornhill Lees, Dewsbury, and joined City as a full time professional in December 1964 from Ossett Albion the Yorkshire League side.

Ian Cooper (full back). Bradford born a former Bradford and Yorkshire Boys player. Joined City as an amateur in September 1962, turning professional in August 1966.

Bruce Stowell (wing half). Another local and former Bradford Boys captain. The longest serving player on the books, but just become a full time professional, having spent 8½ seasons as a part timer whilst employed in the local Wool Trade.

Tom Hallett (centre half). Starting his second season with City whom he joined from Swindon Town in May 1966. Had been three seasons with Swindon Town and before that spent six years at Leeds United. Is a native of Glynneath (Glamorgan) and joined Leeds United from Swansea Juniors.

Barry Swallow (wing half). Secured from Barnsley at a small fee in February 1967 and was ever present for the remainder of the season. Previously with Crewe Alexandra and his native Doncaster Rovers whom he joined at the age of 16.

John Hall (winger). Had his most successful season in 1966/67 since turning professional in May 1962, scoring 17 goals in 44 League appearances. Was with Huddersfield Town as an amateur before joining City.

Jimmy McAnearney (inside forward). Hails from Dundee and had six seasons with Sheffield Wednesday before moving to Plymouth Argyle. Was transferred to Watford from whom City signed him in September 1966. Appointed player-coach in February 1967.

Charlie Rackstraw (centre forward). Born at Sheffield and played two seasons for Sheffield Schoolboys before joining

Chesterfield. Spent four seasons there before moving on to Gillingham from whom City signed him in January 1967, at a small fee.

Jimmy Cuthbertson (inside forward). A native of Silksworth near Sunderland. Played for Durham County Boys and on leaving school joined Dawdon Colliery Juniors. Came to Valley Parade in the 1964/65 season, and turned professional in the summer of 1966.

Geoffrey Carter (winger). Born at Moulton (Northants) and joined West Bromwich Albion from school in the 1959/60 season. Made his League debut that season and was transferred to Bury in 1966. Joined City in August 1967 for a trial period.

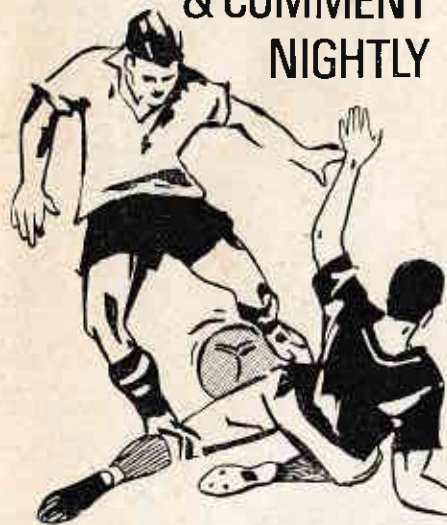

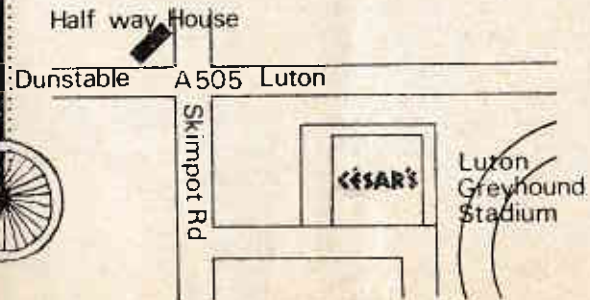
