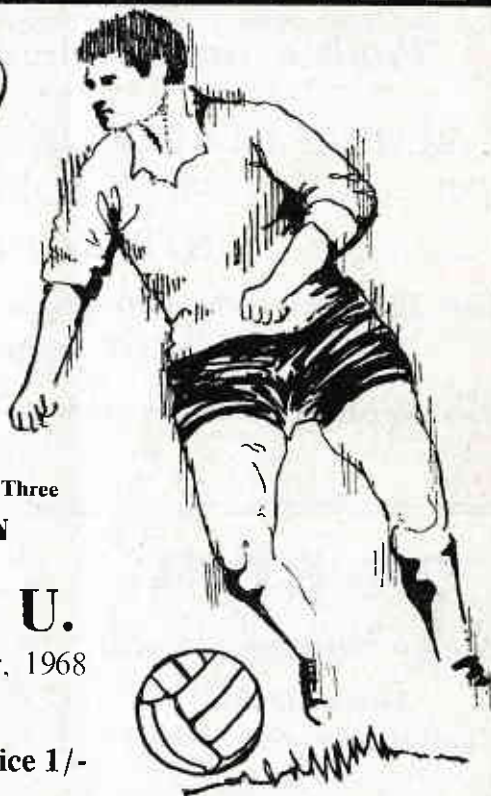

No doubt, the biggest blow to our supporters was the setback at Watford last Saturday when over 22,000 people the Third Division's biggest attendance of the season, saw a hard game in

which we never really hit top form after the shock of being a goal down in two minutes.

Again, the team fought hard against the vastly improved Barnsley team on Tuesday and only a third goal that should have been prevented, cut short our attack in the middle of a grandstand finish designed to produce an equaliser.

Unfortunately, injuries, so often a bane to us since the season began, have struck again, the latest additions to the list being Tony Read and Mike Harrison, while George Potter could not play in Wednesday's reserve match because of ankle trouble.

It looks as if Read and Harrison will have to miss next Saturday's match at Plymouth and, with John Moore still out of action, this represents a high percentage of the First Team pool. Now that the mid-week games are over for a time, the position could well sort itself out.

At the same time, we would like to assure supporters that the hunt for new players of the type we feel would settle down here, goes on relentlessly, and there will be no hesitation about spending when the right man becomes available.

Finally, we draw the attention of our younger supporters at the Oak Road end to the police notice that is boldly displayed on this page.

We, as a Club do not want to run into trouble through a few bad supporters who do not know how to behave. We like them to enjoy their football and sing to their heart's content, but it is absolutely essential that these songs should be kept clean.
