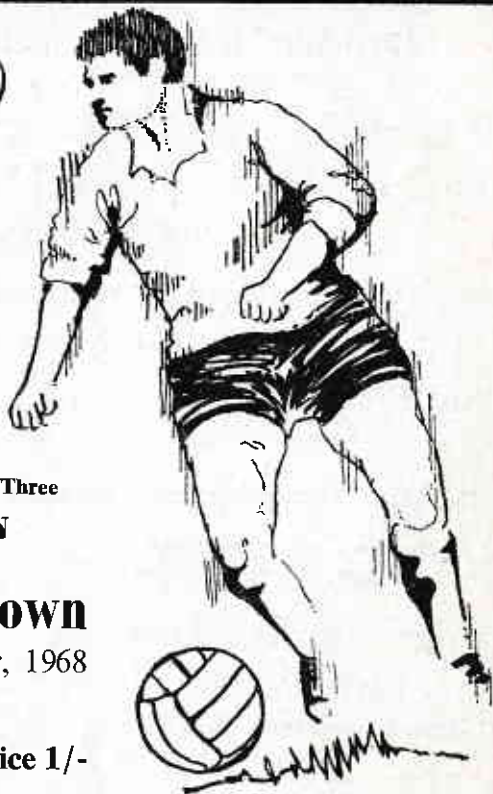

Accordingly, they are expecting to bring a huge following by the standards of these days and this has been confirmed by the number of Stand Tickets which have been booked for coach parties.

Like us, Northampton have had an up and down career recently and they had a brief experience of life in the First Division. Unfortunately for them, it did not last, and they are now striving to regain a place in the limelight of Division II.

There is no doubt that, between them, general manager Dave Bowen who this week, has been in charge of the Welsh team and former England and Wolves wing half, Ron Flowers, have built up a more than useful team and they may well provide us with a tough task this afternoon.

However, our home form, as distinct from that the team has been showing on opponents' grounds is good enough to give us confidence of beating any team in the Third Division.

Today, Sandy Davie, the new goalkeeper from Dundee United makes his League debut in our colours and he is the first in what might become a series of new signings in an endeavour to maintain the bid for promotion.

Four consecutive away defeats certainly have not improved our prospects, but the number of injuries which have overcome key men have had much to do with this rather dismal story.

Among these is the achilles tendon trouble which Terry Branston has developed which, at the time of writing, made him a somewhat doubtful starter against his former Club.

In these days of hooliganism on the terraces of various grounds, it is good to receive the type of letter that came to us this week. It was from the landlord of an Inn near Exeter on whom a couple of coachloads of our supporters called on their way back from Plymouth last Saturday.

He says, "The impression they left with me and my regular customers was of a very high standard. When one hears of hooliganism in various places, it is indeed praiseworthy to know that there are some reasonable people still enjoying their football."

"I would like to commend your supporters for their standard of behaviour and will be pleased to see such customers again."

Finally, we hear that one of our former players, George Dennis, who was by way of being a penalty kick expert, celebrates his golden wedding today. He will be remembered by some of the older supporters and still takes an interest in reading about the Club.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Gordon Morrill (goalkeeper). Signed for the 'Cobblers' on 14th August, 1968 from Doncaster Rovers. He is thought to be the tallest 'keeper in the Football League. Before signing for Doncaster he played for a South African team.

Brian Faulkes (full back). Born Abington. An attacking full back who joined the 'Cobblers' from Reading in the close season of 1967-68.

Clive Walker (full back). Joined the Club from Leicester City in November 1966. An ex-Schoolboy International, Born Leicester.

Ron Flowers (wing half). Won 48 England Caps whilst playing for 'Wolves' and was included in the squad of 40 for the World Cup. Joined the 'Cobblers' on September 1st, 1967 and was appointed Captain of the side. At the commencement of the 1968-1969 season, he was appointed Player-Manager. Born Edlington.

John Roberts (centre half). Born Abercynon, Wales. Joined Northampton from Swansea Town on November 23rd, 1967. Plays either centre half or centre forward and has won Welsh Under 23 honours in both positions.

Frank Rankmore (wing half). Born Cardiff. Was transferred from Peterborough United in May, 1968. He has been appointed the 'Cobblers' new Captain.

Eric Weaver (winger). Born Rhymney. Transferred from Notts County on December 23rd, 1967. Made 23 appearances, scoring 5 goals since joining the Club.

John Byrne (inside forward). Born Glasgow. Transferred from Peterborough United on December 29th, 1967 in an exchange deal for Jim Hall. Plays either inside forward or wing half.

Bob Hatton (centre forward). Born Kingston-upon-Hull. This 21 year old player signed for the 'Cobblers' on October 9th, 1968, from Bolton Wanderers. Previously with Wolverhampton Wanderers.

Tommy Knox (inside forward). Born Glasgow. Signed for Northampton from Mansfield Town on December 22nd, 1967 made 16 appearances for the Club in 1967-1968 season.

Barry Lines (winger). Born Bletchley. This fast and direct winger signed for the 'Cobblers' in 1960.

John Mackin (wing half). Born Bells Hill, Scotland. Formerly an amateur and part time professional player with the Club before becoming a full time professional 4 seasons ago. A very versatile player having played in every position except centre half.

Ray Fairfax (full back). Signed from West Bromwich Albion—his only other previous Club—on a free transfer during the close season. Born Smethwick.

John Clarke (wing half). Played for England Youth and signed professional forms for the 'Cobblers' in June, 1965. Born Northampton.

Joe Kiernan (wing half). Joined the Club from Sunderland in 1963. Also plays inside forward. Born Coatbridge, Scotland.

Dennis Brown (inside forward). Born Reading. Joined the 'Cobblers' from Swindon Town in February, 1967. He made his come-back on March 2nd, 1968 after a very serious car accident from which he had to have his knee cap removed.

Alan Chatwin (inside forward). Born Birmingham. Signed professional forms on his 17th birthday on July 29th, 1968 from a Birmingham local Club, after having a trial with the 'Cobblers.'

John Fairbrother (inside forward). Transferred from Peterborough Utd. on February 16th, 1968. Made 16 appearances scoring 5 goals during the 1967-1968 season.

Graham Felton (inside forward). Born Cambridge. Joined Northampton from Cambridge City in the 1966-1967 season and has had several games in the First Team. Won Youth International honours on several occasions.

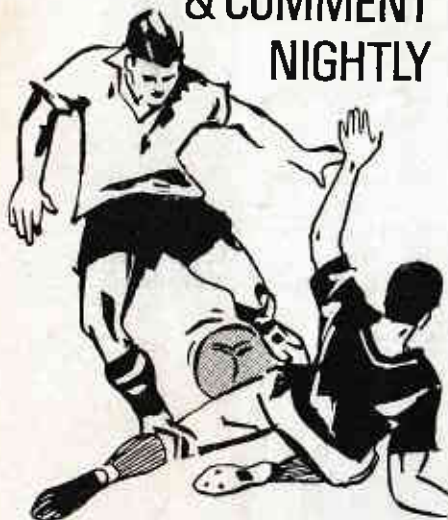

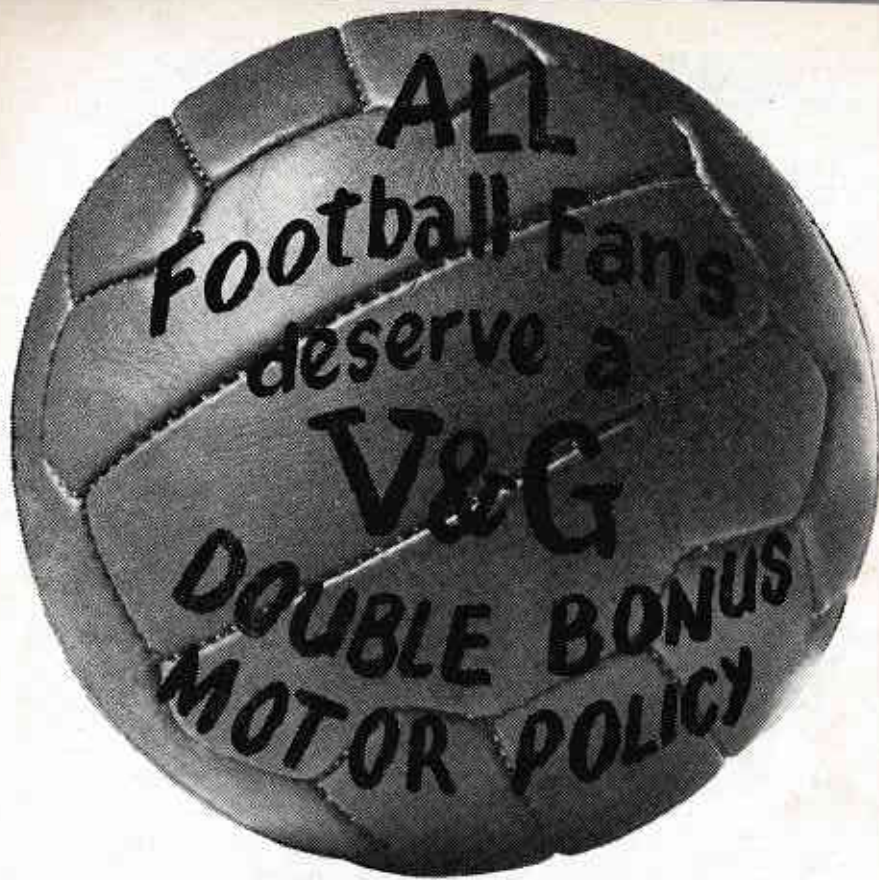
