### CLUB NOTES

WITH the luck of the draw in the F.A. Cup having operated in our favour at long last we welcome today. Ware Town, an ambitious amateur outfit who have reached the First Round of the national competition for the first time in their history.

They come here with a strong following, determined to put up a good account of themselves and, certainly, our boys will not make the mistake of under-rating them.

Curious things happen in football, but with the confidence of a 100 per cent record behind them, our team should qualify to take part in Monday's draw for the second round with something to spare.

There was another good performance here last Saturday when Swindon Town's run of six consecutive League victories was brought to an end, as a result of which we got back firmly into the promotion race.

A further step in this direction could be taken next Saturday, when Bournemouth, another club who have ambitions about admission to the

Second Division, will be the visitors and we expect a bumper gate.

In fact, already, we have received a lively demand for centre stand tickets and they are indications, too, of a sell-out for the home match with Watford on Boxing Day. Tickets for this match will be available shortly.

Should a replay of today's match be necessary it will take place on this ground next Wednesday (7.30), Ware having waived their ground right.

One of the problems which we have had to face recently has been the lack of car parking facilities available for supporters, but this has been remedied to some extent.

As from today, parking space for 600 cars and 50 coaches will be available on the Dal Road Industrial Estate which is only a few minutes walk from the ground and this should ease the situation considerably.

Charge for cars is 2/- each, with coaches 5/-, and we should emphasise that none of this money comes to the Club, but that we are only too pleased to be able to provide this service.
