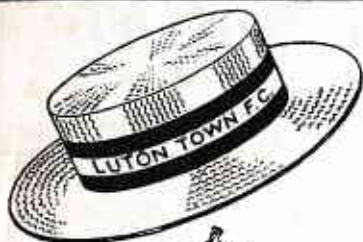

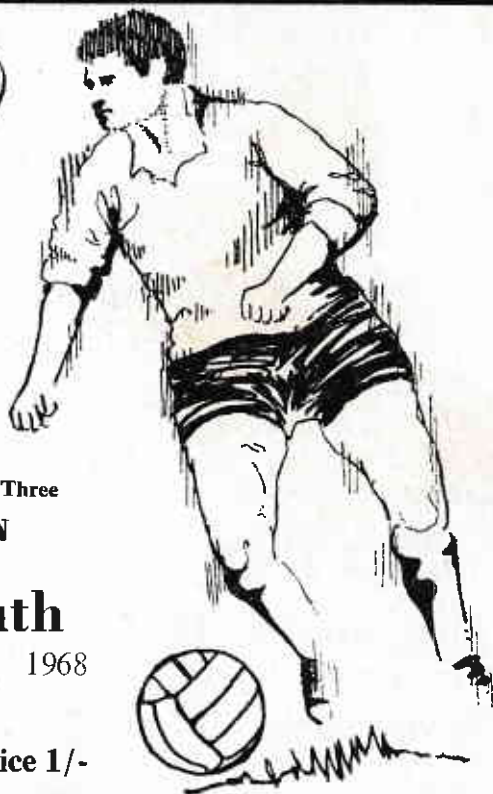

CLUB NOTES

ANOTHER cliff-hanging top of the table duel is on the cards this afternoon when Bournemouth, present leaders of the Third Division by a bare margin, are the welcome visitors. This is definitely a case of a match being worth four points because victory to us would enable us to draw level with the seaside team.

On the other hand, defeat, the possibility of which we do not contemplate for a moment, would enable Bournemouth to draw four points clear of us at the top.

So, all the implications of this struggle are clear and both teams will be only too aware of the issue at stake.

With the issue so open at the moment, every match we play assumes a vital character and that will be the case at Stockport next Friday evening because, this morning, the County were immediately above us.

Again, the margin is slight—only one point, and we have a match in hand,* but these are two vastly important matches as a prelude to the Cup-tie with Gillingham a fortnight today.

Again, the draw has favoured us with ground advantage and we expect a big crowd for the visit of the Kent team who are skippered by our former player, Gordon Riddick, who scored

the goals that enabled them to win the replay with Orient.

Similar ticket arrangements to the last round will obtain—only the centre stand being reserved at 9/-. Season Ticket Holders have until next Wednesday week at 6 p.m. to claim their usual seats, either personally, or by post, enclosing remittance, stamped addressed envelope and the slip for Round 2 from their books.

Tickets are also available for the match with Watford on Boxing Day and we should perhaps warn supporters that there has already been a heavy demand.

It would be inappropriate to end these notes without paying a tribute to the gallant and sporting display put up by our amateur opponents, Ware, last Saturday. While they did not exactly give us a scare, they certainly made it difficult for us to achieve the important, initial break through.
