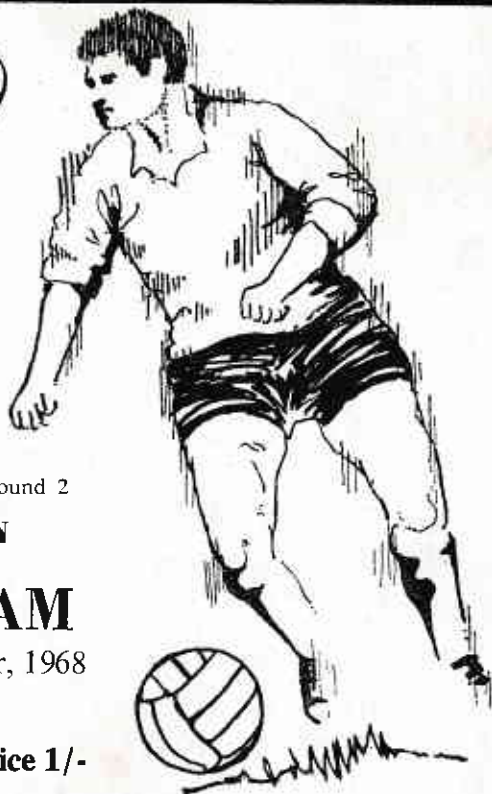

CLUB NOTES

TODAY, we give a warm welcome to our friends from Gillingham and especially to their manager, Basil Hayward, whom we used to see much more often when he was in charge of Bedford Town.

Since he moved to Kent, he has certainly kept contact with Bedford because there are several former "Eagles" on his books, in addition to our former player, Gordon Riddick who is Gillingham's captain.

Although they provided us with our only away win of the season so far, Gillingham will certainly be no pushover this afternoon because all reports indicate that they have made a considerable improvement since we met them but, at the same time, there is complete confidence that we shall repeat the victory gained over them at the same stage of the F.A. Cup competition four years ago.

Unfortunately, our drive for promotion is not gathering the momentum we had hoped, purely to the inability of the team to achieve any measure of success in away matches.

Defeat came again at Stockport last Friday and one is rather at a loss to explain why goals and points are not coming so regularly as they should. However, there is a long way from being a spirit of despondency in the camp because we are still very much within a striking distance of the leaders and there is a long way to go.

If a replay of today's match is necessary and it is hoped it will not be in view of the fact that the team is due at Hartlepool next Saturday, it will be at Gillingham on Wednesday kick-off 7.30 p.m.

For the comfort of the supporters who use the Bobbers Stand, we have decided to seal off the gap that has been used by some of the regulars

behind the Oak Road goal to push their way through the crowd to the Kenilworth Road end for the second halves of games.

There have been complaints to which we have been glad to listen and movement through the crowd from that end has now been completely restricted.

Naturally, though people on the open Kenilworth Road terrace who wish to seek cover, can still make their way to the Bobbers side.

We would remind supporters that car parking accommodations is now available on the Dalroad Estate in Dallow Road (about 500 cars) and in Maple Road (about 250) which goes a long way towards solving the problem.

A reminder, too, that on Wednesday week, there will be an additional attraction in the shape of star continental opposition in Slavia (Prague), who will be visiting Kenilworth Road for a friendly match after meeting Sunderland and Stockport County.

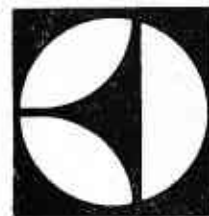

Ray Bailey (wing half). Signed from Bedford Town in May, 1966. Professional cricketer with Northants, appearances curtailed last season by a cartilage injury.

Mike Green (utility player). Signed from Carlisle United in June, after spending three seasons with his home town Club.

Derek Woodley (winger). Signed from Southend United in January, 1967. Born at Isleworth, started his career with West Ham United.

Brian Yeo (inside forward). Born Worthing, signed from Portsmouth in the Summer of 1963. Made his 100th League appearance at the end of last season.

John Meredith (winger). Born near Doncaster, started with Doncaster Rovers and moved to Sheffield Wednesday. Signed by Chesterfield and left for Gillingham in March 1964. Has made 182 League appearances in just over four seasons.

Ken Osborn (winger). A Londoner, ex-Q.P.R. apprentice, signed in June, 1966.

Bob Harrison (inside forward). Born Gillingham, signed professional forms in June, 1967.

Bobby Folds (inside forward). Born Bedford, former apprentice professional and signed senior forms in November, 1967, after recovering from a leg injury.

Carl Gilbert (inside forward). Born Folkestone, signed from the Army in October, 1965.

Andy Smillie. Signed from Southend United. Made his League debut for West Ham United in 1958/59 and has also seen service with Crystal Palace, Scunthorpe United and Southend United. Was contemporary with Derek Woodley at Upton Park and Roots Hall. Has scored 2 goals in his 6 games with us so far.

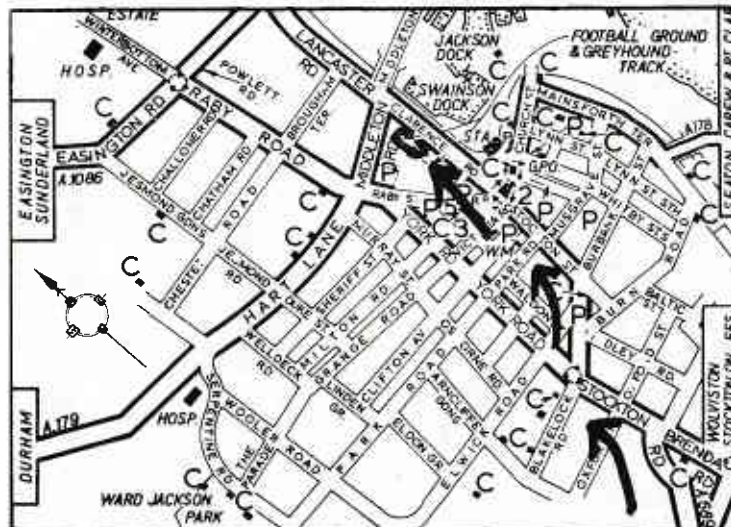

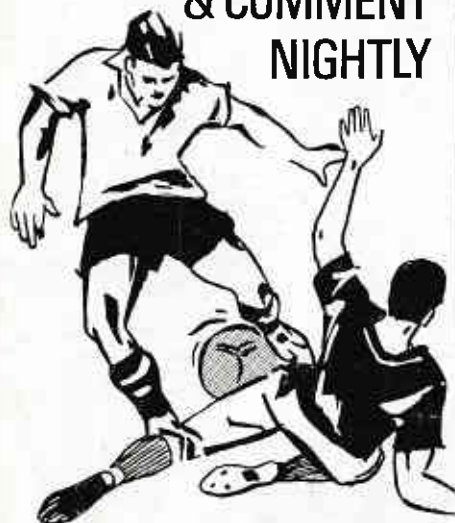

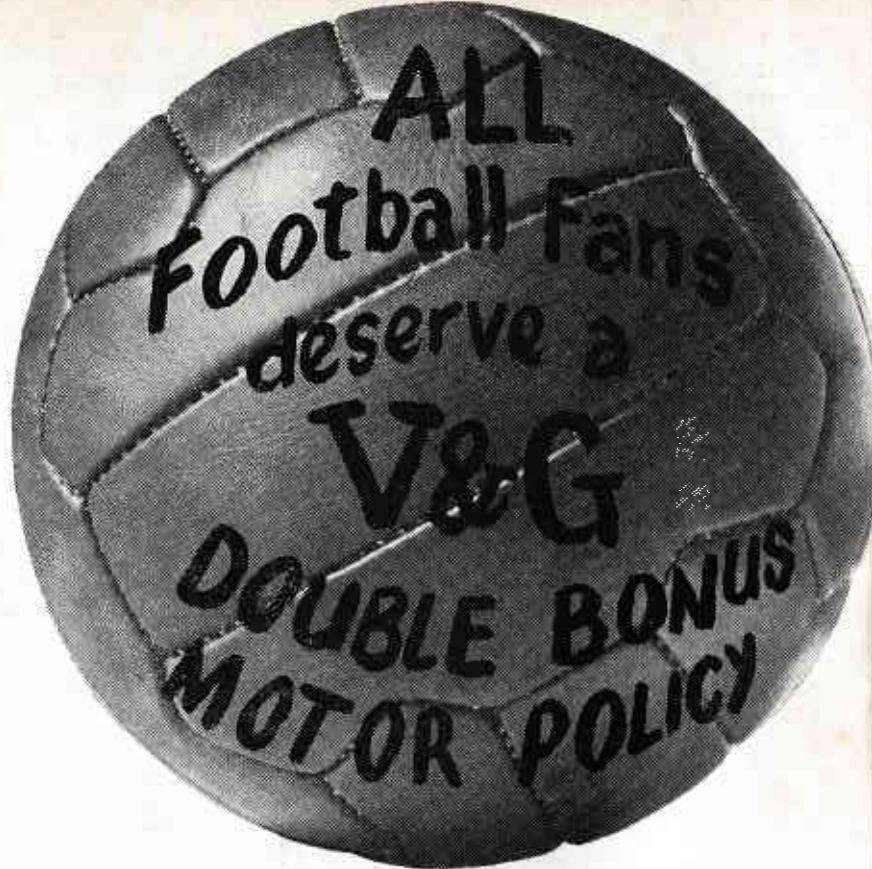
