

CLUB NOTES

HAVING again failed where they were expected to gain some success—at Crewe on Wednesday—the pressure on the team is vastly increased this afternoon when Reading, reasonably mear neighbours of ours, are the visitors.

The continuing inability to score with any sort of frequency in away games is a source of bewilderment and, certainly the position has not been improved by the unfortunate blow we were struck at the beginning of the week

Then we learned that Bruce Rioch. that highly stalented young inside forward, had to have a cartilage operation which is expected to keep him out for six or seven weeks.

Of course, this blow has come when we could least afford it because the aim in the next few weeks is to step up the promotion challenge and Rioch was an integral part of the plan, of course.

Wednesday's setback at Crewe has not helped matters in the slightest and the failure was all the more disappointing in view of the splendid performance put up against Swindon a team much better equipped from the playing point of view than are Crewe.

However, full marks to the Cheshire side for their great fighting spirit. though we thought we were unlucky to concede the vital first goal in a match that began to have the hallmark of a goalless draw.

There seemed little doubt that Davie was obstructed, which caused him to lose possession of the ball and leave an eminently takeable scoring opportunity.

Only too keenly are we aware that promotion is not won on home points alone and, to be in the reckoning at the end of the season, more consistency must be shown on opponents' grounds.

This is somethling which Manager Alec Stock has been preaching continually since his arrival and last Wednesday's setback was particularly disappointing to him because the Swindon performance must have gone some way to convincing him that the answer had been obtained

Now, the immediate task is to restore confidence with a convincing win this afternoon and then an all-out attempt to overcome another tremendous obstacle next Saturday when we are due to meet Bournemouth, who also have ideas about promotion, at Dean Court.

Doubtless, we shall have a big following on this occasion to encourage the team in their tough task.




