Incidentally, like the First Team, the Reserves are enjoying a successful run which is geltting them away from the lower reaches of the Combination table. They secured a fine 3-0 win at Reading on Wednesday, with the goals coming from Ian Buxton, John Ryan and Morris Stevenson and they went to Southampton today with a run of six games without defeat behind them.

Some complaints have been received from supporters who watch the games from the Bobbers Stand about people pushing through their ranks to get to the other end of the ground. We tried to combat this nuisance by building a fence but this has been smashed and it is difficult to find a solution.

However, we do appeal to those who are causing the trouble to desist because this is a case of the majority spoiling things for the majority.

Finally, we would repeat that season ticket holders will not have to pay for their seats at the re-arranged match with Watford, but will be able to use a spare ticket in their books.




