



If there is a serious repetition we shall have to close the mini stand down-a move which will hit the club and many sport loving people of Torbay who come here for 90 minutes entertainment and enjoyment.

This club has been renowned in the past for the sportmanship of the spectators. The behaviour of a small minority of hooligans is ruining the reputation which Torquay Utd. has built up over many years. It cannot be tolerated.



IACK EDWARDS

Torquay Utd. have one of their greatest assets in Jack Edwards, the club's Chief Trainer-Coach, a modernminded and completely dedicated man who puts all his energy and knowledge into his duties.

He joined Torquay Utd. in season 1964-65 to head the club's scouting organisation but when Frank O'Farrell came here as Manager, Jack Edwards was appointed Chief Trainer. There is no doubt at all that Jack Edwards' work contributed a great deal to the successes which we enjoyed in the years which followed.

Edwards became caretaker manager in the interval between the departure of O'Farrell for Leicester City and the appointment of Allan Brown as Manager and fully justified the Board's confidence in him.


Clubs he served with as a player included Crystal Palace and, in fact, he was a member of the Palace team which deprived Torquay Utd. of promotion to the Second Division at the end of Season 1948-49. His close association with Westcountry football began when he was appointed Exeter City trainer in 1962. He took over as Manager of Exeter in 1963, steering the club to promotion to the Third Division.

Mr. E. D. WALLACE

Mr. Wallace's experience as a referee dates back to 1949 and he graduated to the Football League via local, County and The Western League. In 1960-61 he was appointed a Football League linesman and was promoted to the Referees List in 1964-65.

He has had a good deal of international experience and was linesman for the D.W.S. Amsterdam v Lyn Oslo match in the 1964 European Champion Clubs Cup and for the Liege v Atletico Madrid Inter Cities Fairs Cup match in 1965.

Mr. Wallace was also linesman for the F.A. Cup Final in 1966 between Everton and Sheffield Wednesday.

Aged 38, he is a Production Technician with British Rail. A married man, he is the father of two children, a son and a daughter.



The Men from Luton


