In the circumstances, it is as well that there is ample cover for each position and that the Reserves have run into such impressive form in recent weeks.

Tonight's visitors, Southport, very nearly put a spoke in the wheel of our rivals, Watford, a week ago, when they were unlucky not to gain a point at Vicarage Road and on the face of things, we can expect them to put up an equally resolute fight tonight.

However, our unbeaten home record still remains intact and we see no reason why it should not remain so for next Saturday when Brighton will be the visitors and we shall be meeting them for the fourth time this season.

Two of these encounters were in the League Cup in which we beat them 4-2 here after a draw on the Sussex's Club's ground. The away League encounter, we lost by the only goal, and we expect to improve materially on that result next week.
