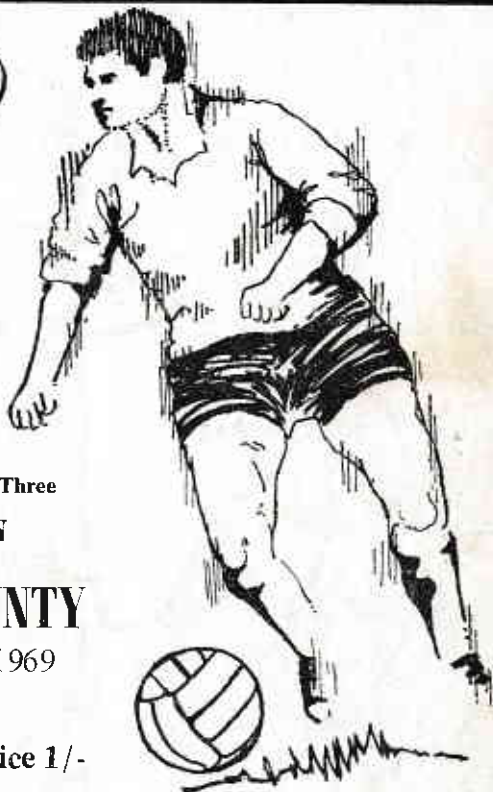

CLUB NOTES

WHILE it rather looks now as if our promotion hopes for this season have been buried, we cannot afford to neglect the chance that Swindon might lose their two outstanding matches and that, by winning both ours, we could gain the prize on goal average.

It is a remote hope, it must be admitted, but the fact is that there must be an all-out drive for two points from the visit of Stockport County tonight and for two more when Watford come here next Wednesday.

Then it will be a case of sitting back to await the result of Swindon's remaining games, at Rotherham a week tonight and at home to Barrow on Monday week.

If narrow failure is to be our portion, then it will not have been for the want of a great effort, especially last week when we returned with three points from two hard fought matches in the North West.

The two points gained from Tranmere a week ago were especially praiseworthy and the team has overcome the handicap of a crippling number of injuries in the bravest possible fashion.

Not only that, but the matches have piled up on the players in rapid succession, so that there has been the minimum of rest. Unusually before tonight's game, they have had a

week's break and that should reflect in their play tonight when it is expected that they will go out on the hunt for a highly decisive win.

With Watford, following their defeat at Barnsley, still needing a point to make certain of the Championship, their visit here next Wednesday evening has assumed vital importance again.

So now, we are expecting to have to cope with a capacity attendance and in this respect, we ask for the fullest co-operation from all the spectators.

In the first place, we appeal to them to come early so as to ease the congestion that could occur at the turnstiles.

And, once in the ground, we ask them to pack as well as they can on the terraces and to give the stewards, of whom there will be extra on duty, their fullest co-operation.

Only if this is done will everyone who wants to see this match be able to do so in reasonable comfort. Obviously, Watford will bring a big following and it is likely that the majority of their supporters will arrive early.

So it behoves our own fans not to leave their arrival until the last 10 minutes or they may find themselves missing some of the excitement.

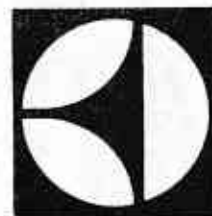

Born in Hull. Signed this close season from Hull City. Has been made the Club Captain for the coming season.

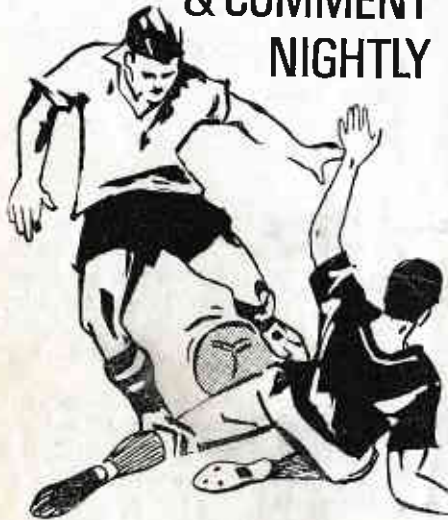
Alan Ogley (goalkeeper)

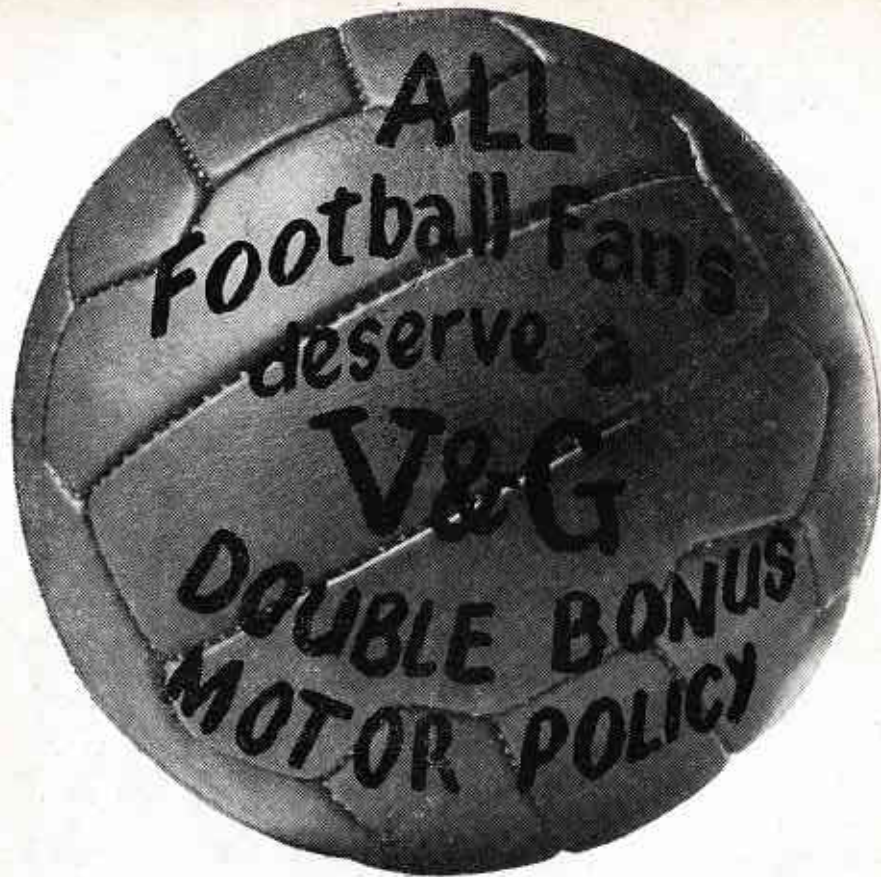
