

TEES IS 69/70 USING HIS HEAD

Walsall 1, Luton 3

TWO goals from Matt Tees, Luton's £25,000 signing from Charlton, put the Third Division leaders well on the way to victory and extended their unbeaten run to 17 games.

The match started sensationally with two goals, one for each side, coming in the first two minutes. After only 25 seconds Parkes was penalised for carrying the ball.

Collins floated the free-kick into the middle where Tees glanced the ball home with his head.

In the next minute Nichol obstructed Woodward. Train touched the free-kick sideways for Taylor to smash home his first goal since rejoining Walsall from Crystal Palace four matches ago.

Booked

In the 23rd minute Slough was booked for kicking the ball away and three minutes from the interval Luton's Dougan was carried off with a knee injury.

A mistake by Parkes led to Luton regaining the lead. He failed to come off his line to meet a Keen free-kick and Tees headed his fifth goal of the season.

Before and after this goal Luton had an escape. Taylor shot across the face of the goal and Crowe had a shot beaten down by Davie.

But Luton got their third goal in the 68th minute, and again it came from a free-kick.

Collins turned Bannister's free kick through Harrison's legs before beating Parkes.
