

# Luton crash to first defeat

Doncaster 2, Luton 0

Doncaster sent the Third Division pacesetters crashing to their first defeat this season with a brilliant, hard-working display.

Rovers' outside-right Usher gave the Luton defence the most trouble and he also found time to run back and cover for his own rearguard. But it was Luton's Slough who gave Doncaster the lead in the 33rd minute when he headed a centre intended for Wilcockson into his own net.

The goal was the result of some tremendous pressure by the Doncaster forwards, who fully deserved to be in front at that stage. Luton fought back desperately and brought on substitute Sheffield, a former Doncaster player, but he could make no impression against his old team-mates.
