



No. 5 — BILL BARKER

The Rovers physiotherapist is perhaps better known to our supporters as Trainer of the Reserve side, but now he is devoting most of his time to the job of getting injured players fit again as quickly as possible. Bill is a Goldthorpe-born man and not only did he play for his school but for three years played for

the Dearne Valley Boys, as well as a final trialist with Yorkshire Boys. On leaving school he worked at a colliery and joined Frickley Colliery Athletic, then in the Midland League, when 17. He later played for South Kirkby Colliery (Yorkshire League) and then went on to Oakwell, where he played in their Central League team. About to join Grimsby Town on the outbreak of war, he was called up for the K.O.Y.L.I., and was soon in France, where he played for the British Army v. French Army. Taken prisoner in Italy, he was a prisoner of war for five years but was selected from several large camps to play for England v. The Rest of the World. After his return home he played for Barnborough Main and then joined Rotherham United in charge of their juniors. Later again he was appointed Manager of

Denaby United and six years ago joined the Rovers staff. A schoolboy boxing champion of Yorkshire, Bill has little recreation time but is a "Do it yourself" expert, with emphasis on woodworking.

OUR VISITORS

Welcome to Luton Town and their supporters this afternoon. It is just over two years ago since the teams met at Belle Vue—on October 3rd, 1967—and then the Rovers won 2-0, our scorers being Bobby Gilfillan and Graham Watson. At present the Town is going all out for a return to Division II and have a fine record to date. In fact, their away games have yielded two points each at Bournemouth, Gillingham, Plymouth, Southport, and Walsall, and one at Valley Parade, Bradford. Recent acquisitions to the team are Chris Nichol, the former Halifax Town pivot, and Matt Tees, the former Grimsby Town and Charlton Athletic leader. Laurie Sheffield, the former Rover, is also a member of the Town staff.

Formed in 1885, it was a fusion of Luton Wanderers and Luton Excelsior. Known as "The Hatters" in those days, it is possibly as the result of straw 'boaters' being then manufactured in the town. They were the first professional club in the South of England. Here is a potted history from then on:-

1895-96 Members of the Southern League; runners-up in their first season.

1897-98 Elected to the Second Division, Football League, in place of Burton Wanderers.

1899-1900 Lost place in Second Division to Stockport County. Re-joined Southern League.

1920-21 Members of the newly-formed Third Division (South).

1935-36 Runners-up in Third Division (Southern Section) to Coventry City.

1936-37 Champions of the Third Division (South) with 58 points. Promoted to Second Division.

1954-55 Runners-up to Birmingham City in Division II, City winning championship on goal average. Promoted to First Division.

1958-59 Losing Finalist in F.A. Cup Final to Nottingham Forest.

1959-60 Relegated to Division II 1962-63 Relegated to Division III

1964-65 Relegated to Fourth Division.

1967 Champions of the Fourth Division with 66 points. Promoted to Division III.
Their Kenilworth Road Ground is a fine one, the record attendance there being in March, 1959, when Blackpool were F.A.Cup visitors and 30,069 witnessed the tie.

The following are pen pictures of their players:

DAVIE, Sandy (Goal). Signed last season from Dundee United and made 27 consecutive appearances for Luton. Former Scottish Under-23 International.

JARDINE, Freddie (Right Back). Luton's longest serving player now in his ninth season.

last October from Crystal Palace.
Vastly experienced, he played over
100 League games for Palace and
saw service with West Bromwich
Albion and Scunthorpe United.

KEEN, Mike (Right Half). An £18,000 signing from Q.P.R. where he spent ten seasons. More than that, he captained them in their rise from Division Three to Division One and did not miss a match in the process.

NICHOL, Chris (Centre Half). Signed from Halifax Town during the current season. Large fee involved. Previously with Witton Albion and Burnley.

SLOUGH, Alan (Left Half) This 21 year old is Luton's most valuable asset. Worried by rumours that he might be transferred he asked for a long term contract and has now signed for six years.

COLLINS, John (Outside Right). Previously with Reading.

ALLEN, Keith (Inside Right). Has filled a variety of positions for Luton, and is equally at home either as a midfield link or a striker. Previously with Portsmouth, Stockport County and Grimsby Town.

TEES, Matt (Centre Forward). Signed during the current season from Charlton Athletic, previously with Grimsby Town.

MACDONALD, Malcolm (Inside Left).
A former Fulham player.

FRENCH, Graham (Outside Left).
Signed from Wellington Town for £5,000. Previously with Shrewsbury Town, Swindon Town and Watford.




