

Allen makes up for it

Rotherham 1, Luton 1

MUCH of Luton's play was attractive and pleasing to Rotherham's biggest crowd for some weeks, but at the same time they left a bad impression.

Intent on saving a point after they had grabbed an unexpected equaliser, they were glad of time-wasting methods, and under Rotherham's desperate late pressure they were moving the ball about in their own penalty area without making any attempt to go on the attack.

A bad blunder by Allen gave Rotherham their goal three minutes from half-time. He jumped up in the penalty area to fist the ball away when there was little prospect of a goal, and Leigh, scored with ease from the spot.

Seven minutes after half-time, Luton equalised, and no one was more pleased than Allen, who sneaked in unobserved to meet a corner from French and headed in before Rotherham defenders had time to size up the situation.
