### From the Manager's Office

by Mr. JOHNNY STEELE

When I saw the way things were shaping, I said it would take 60 points to win promotion. We cannot reach that target, so must, therefore, accept that we have missed the boat this season.

There is no single factor why we have lost our chance. It is more an accumulation of injuries, suspension to players who are too keen, and loss of form at various times by others.

We accept that we are short of one or two players for certain positions, but we can buy only if we sell first. At the same time we must make sure that we have adequate cover for players we do sell. We would not sell them at all if we were making money.

Although we have averaged about 10,000 for home games, most of the money goes to pay the wages.

Still, I have every confidence about the future. We have brought up players like Tommy Taylor, the Robledo brothers and Arthur Kaye.

There have always been these good players in the area and we are now spreading our net a bit wider because we see our youth policy as the future backbone of the club.

Our Northern Intermediate League side has had a very good season and it has given me deep personal satisfaction to give two of them, Ken Brown and Stuart Barrowclough, their Football League debuts.

We must look to youngsters like these for the future.



**WELCOME TO LUTON TOWN**

**DAVIE, Sandy:** Former Scottish Under-23 goalkeeper for whom Luton paid an £8,000 fee in October, 1968, despite the fact that at the time he was in Dundee United's reserve team.

**RYAN, John:** Close season signing from Fulham, who gave him a free transfer despite the fact that he appeared 45 times in their League side in the previous two seasons. Started his career with Tonbridge and moved to Arsenal before crossing London to Craven Cottage.

**JARDINE, Freddie:** Luton's longest-serving player, being in his ninth season with them. Joined them as an outside-left from Dundee, but is much happier in the defensive position.

**KEEN, Mike:** An £18,500 signing from Q.P.R., with whom he spent 10 seasons, and captained them on their meteoric rise from Division Three to Division One.

**NICOL, Chris:** Signed this season from Halifax Town as a centre-half replacement for Terry Branston, who is now doing more on the coaching side.

**SLOUGH, Alan:** This 21-year-old is Luton's most valuable asset now that Bruce Rioch has gone to Aston Villa, and has signed a six-year contract.

**FRENCH, Graham:** Was the star of England's youth team while with Shrewsbury Town. He went to Swindon Town and then Watford and his next appearance was with Southern Leaguers Wellington Town, from whom Luton bought him for £5,000.

**MacDONALD, Malcolm:** A former Fulham player for whom manager Alec Stock paid £17,500. Another product of the Tonbridge club.

**TEES, Matt:** Signed this season from Grimsby Town to try and add more punch to the attack.

**ALLEN, Keith:** Equally at home either as a midfield link or a striker. Born in the Isle of Wight, he became a professional with Portsmouth and then reached Stockport County via Grimsby Town. Luton secured him in exchange for Derek Kevan.

**HARRISON, Mike:** Came to the fore with Chelsea from whom Blackburn signed him, and Luton paid Plymouth £7,000 for his services nearly two years ago.



The Reds record their seventh successive away game without defeat . . . a club record.




