

# ASTON DOES IT

LUTON ended the Forest's unbeaten League run with only the minimum of effort. The game never called for a high degree of concentration from Luton because of Forest's complete loss of form.

The points came with a 26 minute goal from Aston. The winger was perfectly positioned to pick his spot from 12 yards after the chance had been set up by Ryan.

The goal was an example of how poorly Forest's defence played. Ryan went through unchecked while Aston was left unmarked in front of the goal.

Forest never looked capable of creative football and the only danger for Luton came when a rare shot from Robertson squeezed away from Barber and struck a post.

Luton were more compact. Ryan, Aston and Busby had the defence struggling and only Cottam and Fraser deserved any praise.
