THE NORTH HELD NO MORE GLORY

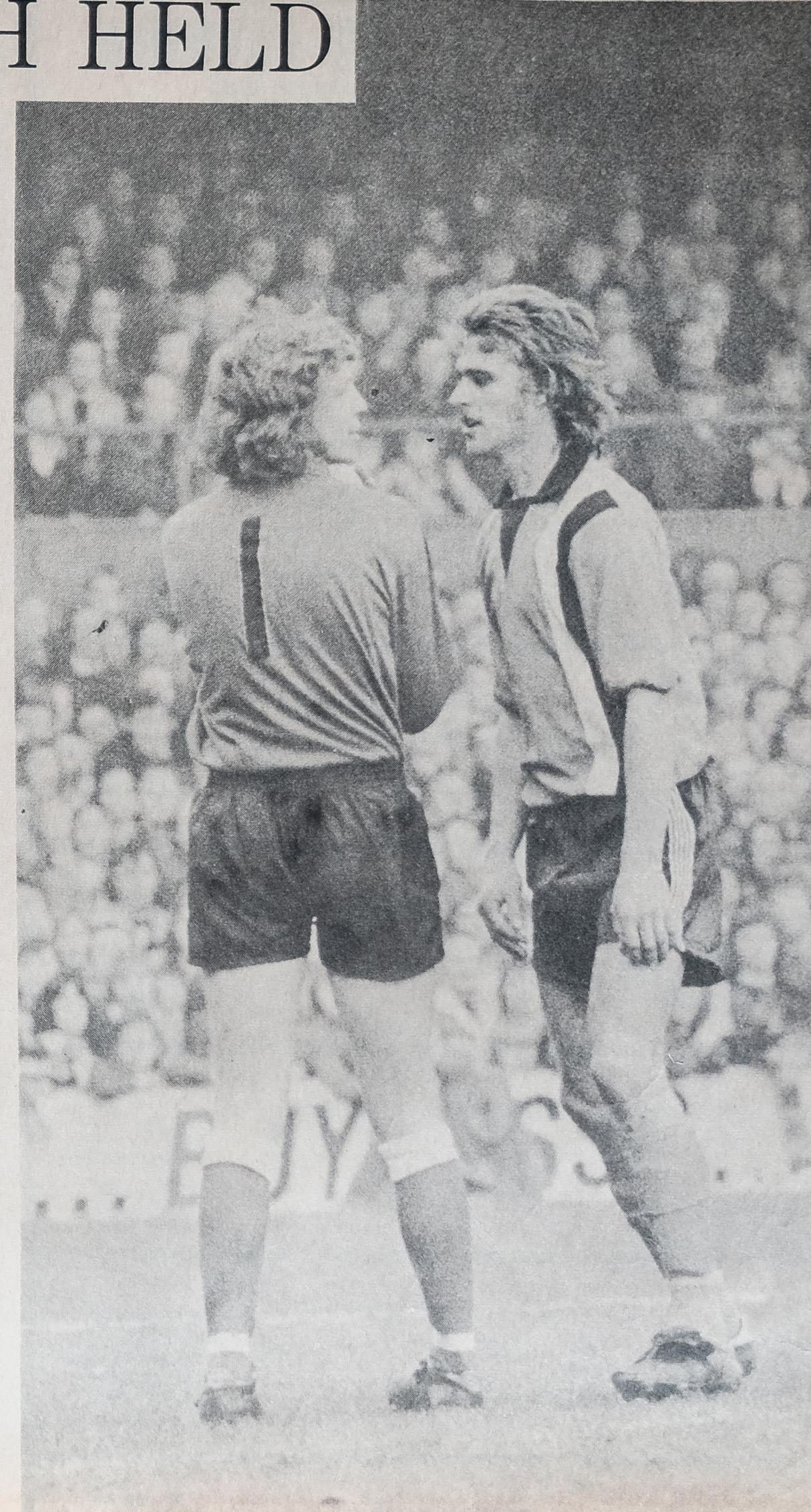
