

TRIALLIST SIMS BOOSTS LUTON

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John Sims celebrated his Kenilworth Road debut on Saturday by scoring one of the two goals that keep Luton in the promotion race and maintain their position as leading scorers in the Second Division.

Sims, 21, a reserve striker with Derby, joined Luton on a month's trial last week. He replaced former Derby tem-mate Barry Butlin, who fractured his jaw against Bolton a week ago.

Excellent save

Only an excellent save by Wednesday 'keeper Springett denied Sims a second goal midway through the second half, but Luton manager Harry Haslam, asked about Sims' future with the club, would only say: "All I'm buying at the moment is time."

Aston gave his side the lead after a quarter of an hour with Sims adding a second in the 42nd minute. Joicey scored Wednesday's goal—only their fifth in nine away League matches—right on half-time.
