

Anderson takes his first goal of season

PUSHED FORWARD into the role of front-runner, Peter Anderson took just 13 minutes to hit his first goal of the season. He is pictured on the right hammering in a goal that was made by Alston's neat header, and taken by Anderson's cool ball control and accurate shot.

Carlisle's back four were split by the speed and accuracy of the movement. It started from half-way inside the Town's half, with John Ryan sending a high through-ball forward.

Thirty yards from goal it was met by Adrian Alston, whose header beat Gorman and took him out of the action and sent the ball towards the edge of the penalty area.
